Com's with strong breeze from the Westward heading N N W. under 2. Sails and courses, Sunset 4:40. Middle pt fresh breeze heading the same. Latter part here to under close reef main top sail and spencers.

Long by C. 78. 26.00.

Com's with moderate breeze from the Westward at 1 P.M. made sail sunset heading N N W. under 2 Sails and courses.

Middle and latter part fresh breeze and squally from the West and N.W. heading both Northward Sat. Ob. 44° 45' S.

Tuesday 9th.

Com's with strong breeze from the Westward and squally steering N N W. W. Sunset more moderate.

Middle and latter part the same steering N N W. all sail set, mended the mastheads and new fore and main tanks.

Sat. Ob. 42° 45' S.

Wednesday 10th.

Long by C. 78. 48.00.

Com's with moderate wind from the Westward and pleasant weather, steering N N W. at 4. saw a sail to leeward, Sunset the same.

Middle and latter part fine breeze from the N N W. steering N N W. Sat. Ob. 40° 26' S.

Long by C. 76. 49.00.

Thursday 11th.

Com's with moderate breeze from N N W. and clear smooth weather steering N N W.

Middle and latter part the same from the South steering N N W. White washed the fore-castle and stowage made Benjamin boat steers of the S. Boat and took in aft in the stowage Sat. Ob. 38° 28' S.

Friday 12th.

Com's with moderate trade from the S. S. E. and clear steering N N W. Sunset the same.

Middle and latter part the same, made a tarpaulin for the tryworks. Cooper repairing water casks. Saw a few transients.

Sat. Ob. 36° 05' S.

Long by C. 78. 09.00.

Saturday 13th.

Com's with moderate trade and clear, steering N N W. Shifted the fore and fore-top sail. Cooper repairing casks.

Middle and latter part the same, same the same at 6 P.M. Made the Island of San Fernando bearing

Sund Ob. N N E. 30 miles, hauled up for it at meridian Middle part of the Island West 5 miles Sat. Ob. 35° 45' S.

Sunday Feb 14th 1858.

At 1 P.M. the Captain and third mate and crew went on shore fishing and caught 2 barrels of sweet potatoes, at 5 P.M. returned on board, kept her N W, Sunset middle part of the Island bearing S. S. E. 10 miles.

Middle and latter part the same course the same, at daylight saw a sail ahead, standing to the S. S. E. at 9. Spotted her Captain Mowbray went on board. She was the 13th rank. Helena of Valparaíso Capt.

16 days from Valparaíso for Talcahuano on short allowance of water gave them 150 lbs of water and the Captain gave us some potatoes Sat. Ob. 32° 36' S.

Monday 15th.

Lying about in company with the 16. Getting on board 3 tons of potatoes, let them have in exchange, 3 bags of tobacco, 15 p of flour, 6 under shirts, 4 p of stockings, 1 sack of 2 pair of blankets, in exchange for the potatoes, at 2. parted steering N N W. the part heading to the S. S. E. arrived.

Middle and latter part moderate from the Westward steering N N W. W. Spaired the fore top sail. Cooper repairing water casks.

Sat. Ob. 31° 55' S.

Tuesday 16th.

Long by C. 78. 37.00.

Com's with moderate breeze from the Westward and clear steering N N W. W. Sunset the same.

Middle and latter part the same course the same Spaired the main top sail Sat. Ob. 28° 23' S.

Long by C. 79. 09.00.

Wednesday 17th.

Com's with smart S. E. trade and clear pleasant weather steering N N W. W. Sunset the same.

Middle and latter part the same, course the same, Sand Ob. at 8 A.M. made Ambrose Island bearing E N E. Cooper setting up shooks for water.

Sat. Ob. 25° 32' S.

Long by C. 78. 32.00.

Thursday 18th.

Com's with light trade and clear steering N N W. W. Employed breaking out and setting up shooks.

Middle and latter part the same same N N W. W. employed as above Sat. Ob. 22° 05' S.

Friday 19th.

Com's with light trade and clear course N N W. W. Employed the same Middle and latter part the same same course N N W. W.

Sat. Ob. 21° 15' S.

Saturday 20th.

Com's with moderate trade and clear course N N W. W. Employed the same Middle and latter part the same course the same Cooper heading shooks Sat. Ob. 19° 35' S.
