Thursday March 11th 1858.

Employed Stowing down the potatoes, tobacco
cask of dry goods with cask (15th 18th) Sunset the vessel
returned in view.

Friday 12th.

Harbour watch on liberty for 3 days the
harbour employed getting off water and stowing
down water.

Saturday 13th.

Employed variously in the afternoon
Hampshire brig came in and anchored.

Sunday 14th.

One watch going in nearly all hands on the

Monday 15th.

Took a raft on shore and fitted it and brought
off 2. boat load of wood.

Tuesday 16th.

Took on board fruit and one small raft of water
Sunset all hands on board, shipped two more
James W. Wilson and Joseph Dwyer.

Wednesday 17th.

At daylight called all hands and manned the
watch at 6. got under weigh heading NW. NW.
the watch employed stowing away anchors and chains.

Thursday 18th.

Came with light breeze from the East heading
NW. NW. Saw great many diamond fish and caught
one, saw several small sharks Sunset almost

L.B. 1. Calm Coast in sight. Middle and latter part

1. B. 1. the same, at 7. Rowed for B. fish and got one to
the S. boat at 9. 30. Spoke the ship Mary
Deliver of New Bedford, Barker, 9 with 131 Sp.

Friday 19th.

At 12. 30 P.M. lowered in company with
the No. 10. for B. fish, the L. B. 10 was captured
the No. 10. 1. water and Captain helped to pick
up the things and bail out the boat, at Sun

10 B. 2. Set took up the boat and took in sail heading

B. B. 1. to the SE. morning and about.

Middle and latter part the same at daylight
breeze forward to the SE.

Saturday 20th. Long by C. 81. 55. 00.

L. B. 1. Came with very light wind from the SE. at

10 B. 1. 3 P.M. lowered for B. fish and got 3. Sunset at

B. B. 1. clear up. Middle and latter part almost

C. B. 2. Calm at 5 A.M. lowered for B. fish and got

L. B. 4. 8. Sunday 21st. Long by C. 81. 55. 00.

10 B. 4. Chasing B. fish about got 4. more. took

B. B. 2. in sail and fired about. B. 1. to the NW.

Middle and latter part lying about in a calm at daylight
lowered for B. fish. Long by C. 81. 55. 00.

Monday March 22nd 1858.

Chasing B. fish at sunset had 22 on deck and along
side, lying about heading to the NW. Middle and
latter part calm lying about. all hands employed -
employed chasing away B. fish. Long by C. 81. 55. 00.

Tuesday 23rd.

Came with very light wind from the SE. heading
to the SE. about finished chasing away the B. fish,
and washed off. at 7. were down to the NW. the watch
employed minding. Middle and latter part the

same at 2 A.M. went down the SE. daylight
made sail and broke a fire. Long by C. 81. 55. 00.

Wednesday 24th.

Came with light wind from the SE. heading
to the NW. saw some porpoise, sunset took in sail

Middle and latter part, the same from 3 A.M.

to 12. lying about finished chasing away the B. fish. Long by C. 81. 55. 00.

Thursday 25th.

Came with light wind from the SE. heading to the NW.

38 B. at 4. P.M. went down to the Southward, at all times up
B. 1. and dusk washed down. Middle and latter part lying about

the same heading to the Westward. Long by C. 81. 55. 00.

Friday 26th.

10 B. 1. Came chasing B. fish the W. boat got one, sunset

10 B. 1. took up the boat and then along to the NW.

10 B. 1. Middle and latter part light breeze and calm

B. B. 1. at 3 A.M. lowered for B. fish and got 3. No Ob.

Saturday 27th.

10 B. 1. Came with calm, chasing B. fish at 1 P.M. got one

1. to the L. B. 1. got one to the L. B. 1. came on board and

clear away the fish, sunset lowered again. Middle and latter part

harbour boats but got nothing at 7. came on board

and then along to the NW. Middle and latter part

five boys from the Southd. stowing NW. 100. Long by C. 81. 55. 00.

Sunday 28th.

Came with fine breeze from the Southd. stowing

NW. 100. the watch employed minding the blubber.

3. m. m. m. a. a. a. for the m. m. m. machine

Middle and latter part the same heading the

same, saw nothing. Long by C. 81. 55. 00.

Monday 29th.

Came with light breeze from the Southd. heading

to the Westward, sunset calm. Middle and latter

part the same heading the same at 6 A.M. made a

fire and began boiling. Long by C. 81. 55. 00.
