

Monday April 12th 1858

Corn's with light and variable wind and cloudy at 1. P.M. went down to the Montevideo Sunset Look in sail and were round to the N.E.

Middle and latter part the same at daylight made sail and steered N.E. & E. saw nothing

Tuesday 13th Late Ob. 8^h 22' N Long 66 20.30.40

Corn's with light winds from the S.W. and Eury caught 3 or 40. bands of water sunset calm. Middle and latter part calm and Eury heading to the Northward saw nothing but porpoises.

Wednesday 14th Late Ob. 8^h 40' N Long 66 20.15.40

Corn's with very light winds from the S.W. and cloudy. Steering N. saw nothing but porpoises. Middle and latter part calm at 9. lowered 3. Tortois the W. Boat and caught 3. tortois. Saw after lowered for 13 fish but did not get any

Thursday 15th Late Ob. 8^h 39' N Long 66 20.12.40

Corn's with very light winds from the S.E. Steering North, 3 boats exploring W. Boat Middle and latter part the same, course the same saw nothing

Friday 16th Late Ob. 6^h 53' N Long 66 20.21.40

Corn's with very light winds from the East Steering North, 3 boats exploring as above Middle and latter part the same course the same saw nothing but a small hawkbill tortoise and caught it.

Saturday 17th Late Ob. 7^h 49' N Long 66 20.28.40

Corn's with light and variable winds and calm, Steering W. at 4. kept her W.N.W. at 5. lowered 1. B. Boats for a sulphur bottom but could not get on. 7 P.M. Calm

Sunday 18th Late Ob. 7^h 55' N Long 66 20.25.40

Corn's with very light winds from the East Steering W.N.W. Sunset calm.

Monday 19th Late Ob. 7^h 57' N Long 66 20.36.40

Corn's with very light winds from the N.E. course W.P.S. Sunset the same. Middle and latter part the same Steering West saw nothing but porpoises.

Late Ob. 7^h 59' N Long 66 20.47.40

Tuesday April 20th 1858

Corn's with light winds from the N.W. Steering West saw nothing but a few black fish, sunset almost calm. Middle and latter part the same heading to the South saw nothing

Wednesday 21st Late Ob. 8^h 33' N Long 66 20.53.40

Corn's with light and variable winds and cloudy heading West sunset the same. Middle and latter part the same course West

Thursday 22nd Late Ob. 8^h 30' N Long 66 20.01.40

Corn's with light winds from the N.E. Steering W.P.S. saw nothing sunset the same. Middle and latter part the same Steering West saw nothing

Friday 23rd Late Ob. 8^h 40' N Long 66 20.44.40

Corn's with light and variable winds and cloudy Steering West, saw nothing but porpoises. Middle and latter part the same Steering West. Sent up the fore topmast stay beam and set the topmast and lower stay sails.

Saturday 24th Late Ob. 8^h 40' N Long 66 20.44.40

Corn's with moderate trade from the N.W. Steering West, sent up main royal yard and sail and sent and set the mizzen topmast stay sail

Sunday 25th Late Ob. 9^h 12' N Long 66 20.54.40

Corn's with moderate trade, and clear Steering West saw nothing, sunset the same. Middle and latter part the same Steering W.P.S. saw nothing

Monday 26th Late Ob. 9^h 14' N Long 66 20.54.40

Corn's with moderate trade, and clear Steering N.W. & W.P.S. saw nothing but porpoises. Middle and latter part the same course the same saw some black fish

Tuesday 27th Late Ob. 9^h 28' N Long 66 20.23.40

Corn's with light trade and clear course the same at 4. P.M. kept her W.P.S. saw nothing but porpoises. 3 boats altering the scuttle over the after hatchway

Wednesday 28th Late Ob. 9^h 36' N Long 66 20.36.40

Corn's with smart trade, and cloudy Steering W.P.S. saw nothing Middle and latter part equally and Eury Steering from W. to W.N.W. saw nothing
