

Thursday June 10th 1858

Corn's with very light winds from the NNE and thick fog steering WNW. Sunset the same.

Middle and latter part smart breeze from the same steering the same foggy. Lat 51.49. N

Friday 11th Long 142.53 W

Corn's with strong breeze from the NNE and clearing and foggy steering WNW under 2. Duff topsail and courses. Middle and latter the same steering WNW. Saw some finbacks.

Saturday 12th Lat 53.17 N

Corn's with moderate breeze from the ENE and foggy steering WNW. Sunset the same. Middle and latter part steering NNE. Lat 53.48. N

Sunday 13th Long 147.26 W

Corn's with light winds from the NE and clearing steering NNE. Sunset the same. Middle and latter part strong breeze and foggy at 8. hour to under close reef main topsail and spencers. at 10. spoke the Europa get 20 15. Black fish seen leaving. Sunday 13th Sun whales 5 times. In three weeks since the weather has been the W. Boat and went off. No 68.

Monday 14th

Corn's with some sun and weather, heading to the NNE the Europa in company at 11. went down to the SLE daylight made sail at 8. tacked to the Westward in company with the Europa. Lat 54.31. N

Tuesday 15th Long 147.29 W

Corn's with light winds from the SSW heading to the NNE at 4. came down to the Europa. and went on board. at 10 came on board and were sent to the SLE. Middle and latter part light and foggy heading variously saw some sulphur bottom and H. logs.

Wednesday 16th Lat 54.57 N

Corn's with light winds from the Westward and clear steering ENE at 3. Rept her N.E. by N.

Middle and latter part almost calm. Saw Sulphur bottom and brown puss. Lat 55.07 N

Thursday 17th Long 146.10 W

Corn's with calm and very light wind from the W. heading to the SLE. Saw the same as above one tail steering towards us. Middle and latter part the same saw almost every thing but eight whales. Lat 55.08. N

Friday 18th Long 145.34 W

Corn's with very light winds from the NE saw the same as above a bark in sight all day. Middle part the same latter part strong breeze steering W. of W. saw a number of finbacks. Lat 55.15. N Long 148.38 W

Saturday June 19th 1858

Corn's with strong breeze from S.E. and hazy steering S.W. by W. saw nothing but finbacks and Sulphur bottom. Middle and latter part fresh gales and thick lying bands. Spence attending S.E. by E. Lat 55.10. N

Sunday 20th Long 150.38 W

Corn's with fresh breeze from the S.E. and cloudy heading S.W. at 1. set the 3 reef main topsail and foresail. Middle and latter part moderate breeze to the S.W. saw some humpbacks. Lat 55.20. N

Monday 21th Long 151.23 W

Corn's with light winds from the NNE and clearing heading to S.E. saw the same. Middle and latter part the same saw 2. sail and some humpbacks. Lat 54.48. N

Tuesday 22th Long 152.33 W

Corn's with light winds from the Westward with heavy head swell heading S.W. Middle and latter part the same and foggy heading to the Southward. Lat 53.44. N

Wednesday 23th Long 153.09 W

Corn's with moderate winds from the S.W. and foggy heading S.E. at 3 tacked to the N.W. under 2 reef topsail and courses. Saw nothing but fog. Middle and latter part moderate and clear heading the same at 5. set the 3 reef topsail to the S.W. saw nothing. Lat 54.02. N

Thursday 24th Long 154.05 W

Corn's with moderate breeze from the NE. started with clear pleasant weather at 2. saw 7 or 8 whales going quick to windward called them R. W. hals but did not board.

Middle and latter part the same plenty of finbacks and humpbacks. Lat 53.41. N

Friday 25th Long 154.49 W

Corn's with moderate breeze from the S.W. heading to the N.W. saw the same. Middle and latter part smart breeze from the same heading to the N.W. saw nothing but finbacks. Lat 54.36. N

Saturday 26th Long 155.34 W

R. W.

Corn's with smart breeze from the N.W. and clearing heading to the N.W. saw some finbacks and some drift wood. Middle and latter part the same at 10. A.M. looked for one R. W. whale but did not get on at 12. came alongside. Lat 54.58. N

Sunday 27th Long 156.34 W

Corn's with smart breeze from the Southward and cloudy heading to the Westward saw nothing. Middle and latter part moderate and calm. Saw 3 finbacks. Lat 54.54. N

Monday 28th Long 158.27 W

Corn's with light winds from the N.W. heading to the S.W. at 3. saw an Island bearing West by Compass.
