Corn's with strong breeze from the East & strong
St. W. saw nothing. Middle and latter part the same
Storing S. S. W. Late 21. 49. S.

Thursday 21st

Corn's with strong breeze from the East & strong
Storing S. S. W. Shifted the main top sail, Middle
and latter part the same at 6 Kpt her S. S. W. at 10. took in
top gallant sails and trysail Late 24. 1. 1st.

Friday 22nd

Corn's with fresh breeze from the East & strong
St. W. saw nothing. Middle and latter part the same
Storing to the S. W. at 10 made all sail Late 25. 59. S.

Saturday 23rd

Corn's with breeze from the S. W. Storing to the
S. W. sunset more moderate. Middle and latter part
light and variable. Drifting to the South & West. Repeating
the fore top sail Late 27. 01. S.

Sunday 24th

Corn's with light wind from the S. Storing S.
4. 0 m. bent and set the fore top sail. Middle and latter part
strong wind squally and rain heading to the South & West

Monday 25th

Corn's with strong wind from the S. Storing to the
S. W. sunset more moderate. Middle and latter part
moderate heading to the S. Late 30. 38. S.

Tuesday 26th

Corn's with moderate breeze from the S. W. and clear
heading S. saw nothing. Middle and latter part
moderate and variable heading to the S. Late 31. 35. S.

Wednesday 27th

Corn's with light breeze from the S. W. and clear
heading South & West. saw nothing. Middle and
latter part the same Storing saw 2 sails on the
S. beam Late 33. 30. S.

Thursday 28th

Corn's with light and variable wind and
fair. Chased with strong rain Storing from S. to
West. W. running down to the 3 sails, at 6. spoke the
Rear Boat Fabius Smith of 11 mths 300. in company with
the Contest and the S. W. at 2.4 mths 250 and the Clark and
Paul of 11 mths 400. took in sail

Middle and latter part the same at 9 lowered for R.
Saw R. Whales and chased till noon without success took
Whale up the boat and stored away Late 33. 26. S.

Friday 29th

Corn's with light wind chasing Whales at 4
lowered away and 3 to and chased till sunset without
getting fast, took up the 6 and took in sail.

Saturday Oct 30th 1858

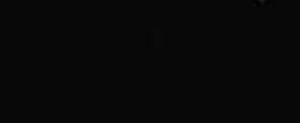
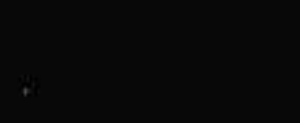
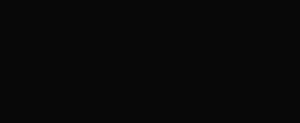
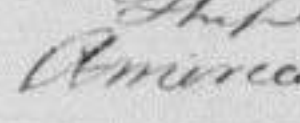
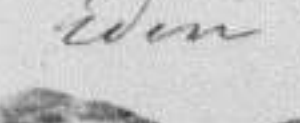
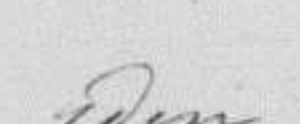
Corn's with strong breeze from the same heading to the
S. at 2. spoke the Contest and Weston bound sunset
took in sail and wore round to the S. W. Middle and
latter part the day light made sail to the East & the Contest
in sight. saw nothing Late 33. 54. S.

Sunday 31st

Corn's with strong breeze from the S. W. and clear
heading to the S. W. saw nothing sunset took in sail
Middle and latter part fresh breeze and clear heading S. at 8
8. Kpt off S. E. saw nothing Late 34. 54. S.

Monday Nov. 1st

Corn's with strong breeze from the S. W. and strong
Saw R. saw nothing. Middle and latter moderate and clear at
Whales 6. 4. 1/2 lower fore top sail and chase until 9. but did not
get on. at 10 Capt. Andrew Cummins and crew along
S. E. in company Late 35. 36. S.



Corn's with very light wind from the South & clear
Even at 1. saw a Wh. whale in our wake, galley did not
lower. Middle and latter part almost calm heading to the
East & the 6. in company saw a sail to the West &
boiling Late 35. 21. S.

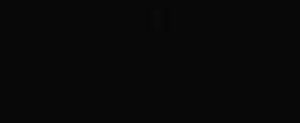
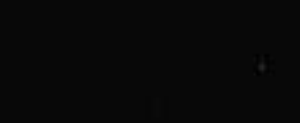
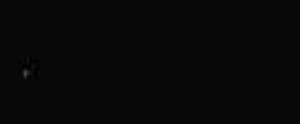
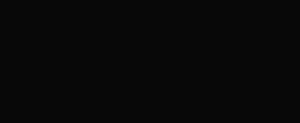
Wednesday 3rd

Corn's with very light wind from the West &
at 1. spoke the America Bryant & Pickens & Shanks
got one whale previous to joining the Shanks
sunset took in sail heading to the S. a bark.

Middle and latter the same at day light saw a sail
and later S. E. saw three sails Late 35. 44. S.

Thursday 4th

Corn's with fresh breeze from the S. W. at 2. lower
for 2. W. sails, but could not get on to them, saw another
Whale born fluke, to windward 2 1/2 miles off sunset took
in sail. Middle and latter strong breeze, going to windward
M. Top sail and fore top sail, foggy and rainy No. 6.



Corn's with more moderate breeze from the West &
and foggy at 2. Cleared up set the fore sail and fore
top sail. Sunset took in sail. Middle and latter part
the same heading to the South & day light made sail
saw nothing Late 37. 01. S.

Saturday 6th

Corn's with moderate wind from the S. W. and
clear lower down and stored N. E. Middle and latter
the same Storing N. W. at 10 N. E. Late 36. 06. S.

Sunday 7th

Corn's with light wind from the S. W. and clear
heading to the S. W. saw nothing sunset took in sail
Late 36. 57. S.
