Whales

Sunday Nov. 7th 1858.

Cornis with strong breeze from the NW. Steaming NE. at 5.0 m lowered for R. Whales, but could not get on before sunset. took in sail heading to the S.W.

Middle and latter part breeze from the S.W. heading light ahead to the West. moderate breeze top sail. saw nothing

Monday 8th

Saw R. Cornis with fresh breeze from the NW. Steaming NE. at 1.0 m kept her E by N. at 3.0 m saw R. Whales

lowered and chased but could not get fast took in sail heading to the South. Middle and latter part the same. Saw R. heading to the West. about saw one right whale going to West. quick to lower.

Tuesday 9th

Cornis with strong breeze from the NW. and heavy swell at 1.0 m kept her NE. at 3. saw two whales. Saw R. going quick did not lower. took in sail heading to the S.W. Middle and latter moderate heading to the East. saw nothing but a large school of R. Whales, finbacks and 1. finback.

Wednesday 10th

Cornis with light winds from the E. heading to the East at 2.0 m kept to the S.W. sunset took in sail heading to the West. Middle and latter part very light winds heading to the East. all day light in the air heading to the South.

Thursday 11th

Cornis with calm. saw nothing but 20-30 finbacks. sunset very light from the East heading to the S.W. Middle and latter part light and variable. saw a ship to the East. we heading to the S.W. Sate 36.04.5
Friday 12th

Cornis with light winds from the S.W. and clear smooth weather. heading S.W. saw nothing but finbacks and humpbacks.

Middle and latter part very light and variable heading to the South. Sate 36.30.5
Saturday 13th

Cornis with very light and variable winds and clear. saw nothing. Middle moderate latter

Bank pt strong breeze from the NW. heading to the Union West. at 12. spoke the ship R. Hedges of Say Harbor. 10 m. out 200.

Sunday 14th

Cornis with strong breeze from the NW. heading to the West. at 2.0 m spoke the ship R. Hedges of Say Harbor. 2. Whales this season sunset took in sail heading to the NW.

Middle and latter fresh gale, heading to the NW. Sate 39.39.5
Monday Nov. 15th 1858.

Long 165.53.10.

Wish gale from the N. heading to the West. saw a ship to the West heading to the NW. Middle and latter part heading to the West.

Sate 36.32.5.

Tuesday 16th

Cornis with fresh gale from the West. heading to the South. Middle and latter part the same heading to the South. Sate 37.05.5
Wednesday 17th

Long 165.24.10.

Cornis with the same winds and weather, heading to the South. Middle and latter part the same. latter part more moderate at 10.0 m. we turned to the West and set the 3. reef fast.

Sate 37.15.5
Thursday 18th

Long 164.44.10.

Cornis with more moderate winds from S.W. heading West at 2. set the fore sail and 1. Middle and latter part moderate heading to the NW. saw at sail on the S.W.

Sate 36.35.5.

Friday 19th

Long 165.15.10.

Ship R. Edward Cornis with very light winds from the South. heading to the East. spoke the ship Robert Edward, 10 m. of the S.W. saw a ship 13 m. of the S.W. at 5.0 m. lowered for all whales. Middle and latter part moderate and clear, heading to the North. at 10.0 m. lowered for all whales. the NW 134 struck got steam but soon came himself. almost calm.

Saturday 20th

Almost calm. at 10.0 m. towing the R. Hedges 5 m. of the S.W. a long line and got ready for cutting. chased two more R. Whales but could not get fast. the R. E. in company chasing whales. without success took in sail at sunset heading to the NW. Middle and latter part almost calm at daylight. commenced

Saw cutting at 9. finished cutting and made sail at 10.0 m. lowered for R. Whales without success. Sate 36.20.5
Sunday 21st

Cornis with light winds from the East. heading to the S.W. for cutting at 2.0 m. lowered for R. Whales without success. Middle and latter part almost calm for R. Whales without success. 4. sails in light. Whaling No 65.

Monday 22nd

Cornis with very light winds from the NW. heading to the S.W. lowered for a second whale but got nothing. Middle and latter part strong breeze. saw 5. sails at

Sate 36.53.5

Tuesday 23rd

Long 164.35.10.

Cornis with fresh gale from the NW. heading to the NW. moderate breeze. Middle and latter part at 2.0 m. finished sailing. saw 7. sails around us sunset the same.
