Gave R. W. S. Corn's with moderate breeze from the NE and steady
steering to the NE at 2. lower for 40 whale without
success. Sunset 4. Sails in sight. Middle and latter
pt. strong breeze from the NE heading to the NE at 6.20. spoke
the Cornelia from 40 whale. Sails 39. 15.5

Wednesday Dec 1st Sails 42. 39.5
Corn's with strong breeze from the NE heading to the
NE. at 5. spoke the Vincas. Saw 1 whale for
nothing this season sunset steering with the
Vincas and Cornelia.

Middle and latter pt. strong breeze from the NE heading to the
NE. Saw nothing but 4 ships. Sails 39. 5.5

Thursday Dec 5th 1855.
Ship. Corn's with strong breeze from the NE heading to the NE
spoke the Geo. Throckmold of Nantucket 15 with 7000 lbs.
at 10 this season. Middle and latter pt. strong breeze from
the NE heading to the NE. heavy swell heading to the South. Saw
2 ships. Sails 39. 43.5

Friday 3rd
Corn's with fresh breeze from the West and heavy swell
heading to the South at 5.30. saw 2 whales to midday close
up shore to south and Spencer. Middle and latter pt.
here to heading to the South. Sails 40. 18.5

Saturday 4th
Corn's with fresh gale and heavy sea here to head to the S.
at 5. more moderate set the fore sail. Saw a sail on the Starb
quarter. Middle and latter pt. the same at daylight set
the fore sail and 3 Ruff for to sail. Sails 40. 26.5

Sunday 5th Sails 40. 5.5
Corn's with strong breeze from the NW and light sea
heading to the NE. Saw 2. Sails. Middle and latter
pt. the same here to heading to the South. Saw 40. 18.5

Monday 6th
Corn's with fresh gale from the West and
clear heading to the South. Saw nothing but
the same. Middle pt. the same. Latter pt. more moderate
at 8. set the fore sail close up at 10 the fore sail and
Sails 40. 18.5

Tuesday 7th
Corn's with strong breeze from the West and clear
heading to the South. Saw a sail to midday and
the NE. Middle and latter pt. moderate
and cloudy from the West. heading to the South.
Saw nothing. Sails 41. 20.5

Wednesday 8th Sails 41. 23.5
Corn's with moderate breeze from the West
and clear heading to the South. Saw 1 whale almost
calm. Middle and latter pt. very light heading to the
South. Saw nothing but 40 whale. Sails 41. 34.5

Thursday 9th Sails 41. 20.5
Corn's with light wind from the West and clear
heading South at 3.00 lower for 40 whale without success
Sunset the same. Middle pt. almost calm. Latter pt.
strong breeze from the NE. and thick heading S. W. E.
at 4. here to midday close up to sail and Spencer.

Friday 10th Sails 43. 06.5
Corn's with heavy gale and sea from the West
heading to the South. Middle and latter pt. left
Wind and sea. Sails 43. 08.5
