Cornis with heavy gale from the Westward heading to the South. Saw a ship heading to the NW. Middle and latter part more moderate made sail and sailing saw two sails No Ob.

Sunday 19th

Cornis with strong breeze from the West and thick. Early another heavy W. wind. Saw a ship heading to the South. Middle and latter part very light and variable. Saw 3 Whales, with thick foggy weather looked for Whales but R. W. saw to give them up on account of fog. No Ob.

Monday 13th

Cornis with light W. wind from the NW and foggy heading to the NW. Saw a ship heading to the South. Ship at 9 spoke the ship W. wind about of Seal Island 27 miles W. Wind 2, 300. 18. 3 Whales this season. Middle and latter part light from the South, heading to the West. Lat 43. 46. S Long 153. 34. W

Tuesday 14th

Cornis with light W. wind from the South and clear. Saw 4 heading to the West at 2. Lower part a ship without R. W. saw. Middle part the same. Latter part strong breeze from the NW heading to the NW. Spoke the ship Electro Bowen of New London 18 miles 2400. 32. Whales this season. No Ob.

Wednesday 15th

Cornis with fresh breeze from the Westward heading S. Electro and S. L. at 4. Home to under cloudy main top sail heading N. Middle and latter part moderate heading to the West at 10 kips off. Lat 44. 17. S Long 160. 17. W

Thursday 16th

Cornis with sunset breeze from the Westward heading S. L. saw nothing. Sunset about on a wind to the South. Middle and latter part the same heading Saw 1 to the South at 9 kips off East at 11 saw a small R. W. whale did not follow. Lat 44. 38. S Long 158. 38. W

Friday 17th

Cornis with strong S. W. wind heading East. Saw nothing. Middle and latter part the same. Heading S. W. E. Lat 44. 39. S

Saturday 18th

Cornis with fresh breeze from the South heading N. E. L. under main top gallant sail over St. John's Bay main top sail. Middle and latter part more moderate heading N. E. L. Lat 43. 05. S Long 150. 29. W

Sunday 19th

Cornis with sunset breeze from the South and smooth sea heading N. E. L. sunset the same. Middle and latter part moderate from the NW. heading N. E. L. saw a sail heading to the NW. Lat 44. 49. S Long 146. 45. W

Monday Dec 20th 1858

Cornis with moderate breeze from the Westward heading N. E. L. spoke the Bark Shepherdess Watson of Boston 27 miles 1500. 32. Whales this season. Middle and latter part the same heading to the NW. at 11. kips off. No Ob.

Tuesday 21st

Cornis with moderate breeze from the Westward heading N. E. L. Middle and latter part strong breeze from the same heading East. at 10. took in two sails. No Ob.

Wednesday 22nd

Cornis with fresh breeze from the Westward and cloudy heading N. E. L. under 2. top main top sail and fore sail. Middle and latter part the same heading N. E. L. Lat 42. 08. S Long 137. 09. W

Thursday 23rd

Cornis with fresh breeze from the NW and cloudy heading N. E. L. sunset the same. Middle part the same. Latter part more moderate heading N. E. L. Lat 41. 15. S Long 132. 49. W

Friday 24th

Cornis with moderate breeze from the Westward heading N. E. L. at 6 kips off. E. N. sunset the same. all sails set. Middle and latter part the same heading N. E. L. saw nothing. Lat 40. 52. S Long 129. 36. W

Saturday 25th

Cornis with moderate breeze from the Westward and cloudy heading N. E. L. all sails set. saw nothing sunset the same. Middle and latter part the same. sunset the same. Latter part saw nothing. Lat 40. 57. S Long 125. 57. W

Sunday 26th

Cornis with moderate breeze from the NW and cloudy heading N. E. L. sunset the same. Middle and latter part the same heading N. E. L. at 11. saw nothing. Lat 41. 55. S

Monday 27th

Cornis with moderate breeze from the NW and cloudy heading N. E. L. sunset the same. saw nothing. Middle and latter part the same heading N. E. L. saw a number of faircutts. Lat 41. 46. S Long 118. 25. W

Tuesday 28th

Cornis with light breeze from the NW and cloudy heading N. E. L. sunset the same. Middle and latter part the same heading N. E. L. saw nothing. Lat 40. 33. S

Wednesday 29th

Cornis with moderate breeze from the NW and cloudy heading N. E. L. saw nothing sunset the same. Middle and latter part the same heading N. E. L. saw nothing. Lat 39. 47. S Long 113. 13. W
