and clear by 11. 1/2 hours. S. E. by E. 2 hours

80.26. M. S. M. sent down the mainmast and
repaired it and sent it up again. S. E. End.

Thursday Jan 10th

Gaps and the M. M. Boiling. Muzzies
shorter sail. Middle and Scatter light
air and calm. S. M. hoisted for the
topsails and contents sent down. but a
wings for 12 hours. calm. S. E. End.
