Came in five prizes from the
steering N.W. by N. Employed in
removing the old shore topsail and
hoist. Then sighted the island of
St. Philip bearing S. by N. at 2 hours
Then hauled the old shore topsail
and hoist the old one. Two ships
in sight at 7 hours. Then St. Philip
bearing N.W. by N. dist 15 miles. took
in the light sails and luffed the
ship to the wind to S.W. by N.
Then whaler kept away for St. Philip
whaler passed down between St. Philip
and Amherst Islands at 2 hours
steering S. by N. to E. and
till he saw the voice that Jesus sends
to call us to his arms.
