Wednesday April 3rd

Came in fine breezes from S.E. Whales in sight. Searched Boat first. Waist Boat. Chasing other whales. 5 hours Ship took the whale alongside. 7 hours waist Boat came on Board. Head bearing E.S.E. dist 30 Miles. A.M. daylight. Commenced cutting. About 10 o'clock bearing S.E. dist 40 miles. 12 hours cutting. So Ends.

Thursday 4th

Came in light from S.E. Employed in cutting at 3 hours. P.M. finished cutting. Quarters clearing the decks. 6 hours 45 minutes set the watch. Wherman Island bearing E.S.E. dist 25 miles. Middle wind from N.W. by N.E. Scatter pieces from S. by N.E. S.E. A.M. Employed in cutting up blubber and boiling. So Ends.

Friday 5th

Came in breezes from S. by E.S.E. Employed in cutting blubber and boiling. 5 hours. P.M. Quarters Island bearing N.E. by E. dist 20 miles. 7/41 A.M. Strong current setting to S.W. Wind 3 miles from E. by N.E. A.M. passed Quarters. dist 10 miles. A.M. by an different tracks Boiling. So Ends.

Saturday 6th. Came in cutting. Employed in cutting at 3 hours. P.M. finished cutting. 6 hours set the watch and commenced boiling. Middle and Scatter Boiling. A.M. winds light from S.E. by N.E. 12 hours the same. So Ends.

37. A.M. Came in light airs from E.S.E. by N.E. by E. Employed in Boiling. 10.53. P.M. A.M. 4 hours finished Boiling. Winds S.E. by N.E. Scatter Employed in clearing up the decks. E.C. So Ends.

Sunday 7th

38. Came in light winds from S.E. and S.W. by N.E. dist 10 miles. A.M. and Scatter the same. So Ends.

Monday 8th

Came in fine breezes from S.E. by N.E. 6 hours. P.M. winds S.E. by N.E. by S.W. Middle and Scatter winds from E.S.E. by N.E. at 12 hours. A.M. passed Wherman Island to N.W. of it. dist 12 miles. Employed in stowing down the oil. So Ends.

Tuesday 9th

Came in fine breezes from E.S.E. by N.E. Employed in stowing down at 1.30 minutes Rose whales. Lower 04. A.M. and Searched and Waist Boat took two to the ship. Middle and Scatter light airs and came. A.M. daylight. Employed in stowing of the oil. 12 hours finished stowing and commenced cutting. 12 hours cutting. So Ends.

Wednesday 10th

Came in cutting. Employed in cutting at 3 hours. P.M. finished cutting. Boiling. Middle and Scatter Boiling. 12 hours the same. So Ends.
