Saturday 13th

Comes in light air from S.E.
and calm, one sail in sight.
Employed in setting up
Shocks and Boiling. at
5 hours P.M. a Boat from the
harbour of Valparaiso came
on board. A Mr. Employed in
Coopering oil ready to start down.
10 hours calm checked South
Point Bearing S.E. by E. Saw whales
Breaching to windward 10 miles.
of 12 hours finished Boiling.
So Ends.

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Hamilton. Cruising of the Galapagos.

Sunday April 14th
at 12 hours 30 minutes P.M.
Lowered two Boats to pull up
and see what kind of whales
that was Breaching to windward
at 4 hours Starboard Boat struck.
at 7 hours took a whale to the
Ship. Starboard Boat bearing
S.E. by E. dist 20 miles. A.M.
Commenced cutting. 8 hours finished
cutting. 12 hours Employed in
Boiling. So Ends.

Monday 15th

Comes in light air from S.
Employed in Boiling. At 10
hours saw whales. 10 hours
Starboard Boat struck and
the Port Starboard.
Chasing. So Ends.

Tuesday 16th

Boats Chasing about 10 miles
of Starboard bearing S.E. dist
20 miles. 4 hours P.M. Boats
Came on Board. 5 hours
West and Starboard Boats
lowered again. 6 hours Port
and Starboard Boats struck.
West Boat Line fastened.
Starboard Boat lowered and struck
and took one to the ship.
also the Starboard Boat and
Middle Scoring by the whales. At
day light commenced cutting. 7 hours
Saw whales lower and a Boat
took one to the ship. Port Starboard
Bearing East dist 30 miles. So Ends.
