 8 caught about one Barrel. Ship heading  
 9 to Eastward. Middle and Scatter  
 10 light A.M. Steering E. W. water  
 Employed in painting the Iron  
 work, 12 hours. M. Menman Island  
 bearing S.E. dist. 20 miles Ship by  
 the wind to S.E. by E. 1/2 E. two sail  
 in sight to End. Shipkeeper of Duty.

Sunday May 26<sup>th</sup> P

Comes in light-winds from W.S.W. by to  
 S.W. Sunday Menman Island bearing  
 S.W. dist. 25 miles, one sail in sight,  
 Middle and Scatter fine breeze from  
 W.S.W. by to S.W. E. at 12 hours, m.  
 about 4 hour bearing S.W. dist. 30  
 miles. to End.

Monday May 27<sup>th</sup> P

Comes in fine breeze from  
 W.S.W. by to S.W. E. one sail in  
 sight at sundown at Point  
 of Albermarl bearing S.E. dist.  
 15 miles. tacked Ship heading  
 to S.W. by W. Middle by on different  
 tacks. A.M. the Land, 7 sails in  
 sight one the Ripple of Platanum  
 cutting and the Stary of St. Basket  
 Boiling. 12 hours A.M. Point of  
 Barbera bearing S.E. dist. 15 miles.  
 to End.

Comes in light from S. by on  
 different-tack. 5 sail in sight.  
 at 4 hours P.M. Spoke the Gray  
 Journal of St. Redford. 5 hours spoke  
 the Stary. Middle and Scatter  
 by on different tacks. A.M. 4  
 sails in sight. 12 hours one sail  
 in sight Boiling. A.M. Point of  
 Barbera bearing S.E. dist. 10 miles.  
 to End. Shipkeeper of Duty.

Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> P

Comes in fine breeze from S.  
 by on different-tack. the Stary  
 in sight a Boiling. Sunday A.M.  
 Point of Barbera bearing S.E.  
 dist. 12 miles. Middle and  
 Scatter Steering different courses.  
 12 hours Barbera bearing S.E. dist.  
 5 miles. one sail in sight. to End.

Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> P

Comes in fine breeze from S.  
 by to W.S.W. 4 hours P.M. Spoke  
 the Scutelia. Middle and Scatter  
 Steering different courses, looking  
 for Whales. A.M. 4 sail in sight  
 to End. Shipkeeper sick and of  
 Duty.

Friday 31<sup>st</sup> P

Comes in fine breeze from S. Steering  
 in for about the head of Albermarl. 3 hours  
 P.M. bearing S.E. dist. 8 miles. hauled  
 to the wind of shore. A.M. heading  
 in. Shore. 7 hours spoke the  
 Journal Thomas. 12 hours Steering about  
 for round island. to End.
