Monday June 17th

Came in fresh breeze from S. Stearing
 at 9. Employed in Boiling Blackfish. 4
 hours, and 30 minutes lower for Blackfish
 struck and the Iron drawn from him.
 Came on Board and hoisted up. 4 hours
 finished Boiling. Made S. by the
 wind to S. E. 2 hours. S. by the
 wind. 3 hours heading of shore.
 4 hours heading in shore. 6 hours
 30 minutes Stearing down the Sound.
 12 hours the same to End. Employed
 in setting up shacks, and bending
 the cables. Shipkeeper Sick and of Duty.

Tuesday 18th

Came in fine breeze from S.
 at 12 hour 30 minutes Mr. Castle
 of Point Salera 3 fathoms water.
 Brought out 40 fathoms cable. S. by the
 wind. Employed in breaking out the empty
 water casks, and getting a Raft ready for
 to go on shore. At 10. day light sent
 the Raft on shore, 8 hours went on
 shore and filled it. Employed on
 Board in painting the Iron work. S. by the
 wind. Shipkeeper and John Brown
 Seaman Sick and of Duty.

Wednesday 19th

3. power from 10. Boats went in for
 the Raft. 6 hours and 30 minutes
 took it alongside and hoisted it in.
 At 11. started it and sent it on shore
 again. Shipkeeper and John
 Brown Seaman Sick and of Duty.
 John Brown Crazy

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Thursday June 20th

At 11. P.M. took on Board the Raft
 and stowed it. Making 10. bbls.
 took on Board 4. Boatloads of Wood.
 S. by the wind. Employed in Stowing Wood
 3. Walter Rhogers, Mr. finished Stowing.
 So End. Shipkeeper on Duty. John
 Brown Sick and of Duty.

Friday 21st

Came in fine breeze from S. by the
 wind. Employed in clearing up the
 decks and stowing the Starboard
 Anchor ready for sea. 3 hours. P.M.
 took on anchor and stowed out
 to sea. 3 hours and 30 minutes
 Employed in stowing the cables.
 Saw a couple of Humpbacks lower
 the Starboard Boat, went on and the
 Boatstaples lifted. Came on Board
 and broke him and turned him
 forward. Same, Mires. took Rutt's Seaman
 for Boatstapler. Sundown Shastend
 Skiff for the night. Middle by one
 different tack. At 10. 8 hours lower
 for Humpbacks waist Boat went on
 and struck. 12 hours the Iron drawn
 in light. two S. by the wind at anchor
 and Boiling. Shipkeeper
 and John Brown Sick and of Duty.

Saturday 22nd

Came in fresh breeze from S. by the
 wind. At 10. 30. P.M. by 15. S. by the wind. Humpbacks
 in light. Ship. Bowed to Westward,
 Middle and better strong wind
 and Squally. wind. S. by the wind.
