Steering S. by E. 10 hours. A. M. Larper in light. Sailing from S. E. by E. to S. E. 12 hours dark and cloudy. no observations.

Friday 9th

Comes in fine breeze from S. dark and cloudy. Steering S. by E. Sound dist. 20 miles. Employed in scraping masts, B. C. Middle and latter light winds. Steering S. by E. Latter Employed in setting up Pipe Shocks for water. S. Ende. Shipkeeper of Duty, with Swelled Legs

Sunday 11th

Comes in light breeze from S. in clear. Steering S. by W. Merchant ship in sight by the wind to S. W. Middle and latter fine breeze with light rain squalls. A. M. Steering S. by W. to Ende.

Monday 12th

Comes in light wind from W. W. with rain squalls. by to S. by W. Sunset clear and pleasant Middle and latter S. by W. with thunder and lightning, the coast in sight to eastward of us. 12 hours calm so ends.

Tuesday 13th

Comes in calm with light rain squalls. Sound bearing to eastward, 2 hours S. by light breeze from W. S. W. by to S. W. by 6 hours wind W. by to S. W. bent the cables. Middle thick and rainy with thunder and lightning. at the 10th hour fresh squall from S. split the S. lying jib, A. M. 8 hours clearing away sighted Key Island bearing S. by E. dist. 20 miles. 9 hours calm. 12 hours calm so ends.
