Bark Hamilton, Barrington Bay

Monday August 26th
Ship Laying at anchor ready for sea.
Waiting for the Capt. 2 hours. 8 P.M.
Sawboard and Mast Boat went out
a Boiling 4 hours struck and killed
A Whaupack. and he sunk to the bottom.
10 fathoms or more, parted one line
trying to haul him up, left one boat
to watch by him through the night.
daylight sharks had eat him all up.
So Ends.

Tuesday 27th
Ship Laying at anchor waiting for
the Capt. Boat came on board and
hoisted up Whaupack gone. 5 P.M.
Employed in cleaning the wheel
and varnishing it. So Ends.

Wednesday 28th
Ship Laying at anchor and ready
for sea. Don't know if the Capt.
is sick or not. Not heard from him
for five days. So Ends.

Thursday 29th
Ship Laying at anchor ready for sea.
Capt on shore sick with the Dysentery.
So Ends.

Friday 30th
Ship Laying at anchor, Capt very low.
So Ends.

Saturday 31st
Capt on board the Steamboat Barbora.
waiting to get a passage home.
not being fit for him to stop on shore.
4 P.M. took him on board the Bark.

Barrington Bay
The Steamboat having to tow Lighters
up the Bay. So Ends.

Sunday Sept. 1st
This day engaged a passage home
for the Captain deeming it not
for him to remain here.
Ship left in charge of the first officer
So Ends.

Monday Sept. 2nd
Ship Laying at anchor. Employed in
Blacken the Ber. at 5 P.M. Received
on board 15 Bags of Potatoes. So Ends
Ship in charge of the first officer

Tuesday Sept. 3rd
Ship Laying at anchor waiting for the
Ch. to be repaired; Crew Entered a
Complaint to the American Consul
against the usage they have received
on board of Hamilton; 2 hours P.M.
an officer came on board to investigate
the matter at 3 hour left again
Ship in charge of the first officer
also put the second officer in
as first officer and the third officer
in as second officer; Wind from
the N. and fine weather; So Ends.

Wednesday Sept. 4th
Ship Laying at anchor ready
for sea. Detained by the American
Consul; the Ch. on board the
Barrington to be repaired. Strong
Breeze from the N.W. So Ends.
