Thursday Aug 19th 1802

Pleasant weather emp. getting
Stores on board setting up
The rigging and sundry tools
Hoisted in the long boat and
got all ready for sea —
at 4 am got underway &
set sail at 10 am discharging
The pilot — all hands emp.
Stowing the anchors under
Cable &c — hazy weather
