

Transactions on board the Ship *Hanover* Griffin Barney
Lying off Resolution Bay Friday Sept. 23rd

at 1 p.m. went into the Bay with two boats
went on shore and fill four ft. of water -
at 4 p.m. returned with the water and as many
girls in the boats could carry about 30 in
number - and with much difficulty to keep
them from getting into the boats and hanging
on the boat gunwales - squally all night -
at 6 a.m. sent two boat on shore with fifteen
water galls - at 8 a.m. being about a mile from
the shore the girls all jump over board and
swam for the shore - but others swimming off
all the time - a number of gonorr. along side.
Sund. Strong breezes & clear.

Saturday September 24th
at 2 p.m. the boats returned with the water fifteen
ft. hoisted in our water and stow it away took
in our boats &c. - at 4 p.m. the natives all left
us and we fill away. at sunset Resolution
Bay bore S.E. about 3 leagues - near A.M. B.C.
till 12 then lay by till daylight head to North
at 6 a.m. made Saffron Island bearing N.P.S.
8 leagues and Bora Island North 7 leagues and the
Island of Noo-ke-va S.W. 8 or 9 leagues - at Noon
The Entrance of Contadora Bay in the Island
of Noo-ke-va bore N.W. 3 leagues -
Tried breezes & clear.

Sunday September 25th

at 2 p.m. have two off Tong-hay bay
and sent the whale boat on
shore at 5 the boat returned.

Brought off an English Man by the Name
of Roberts and a number of lady's &c. -
Lay off and on all night at 7 a.m. sent
the boat on shore with the lady's they
being very sick - Roberts informed
us that the ship *Conider* left here
the eighth of June - that Mr. Michs the
super cargo of the *Conider* had informed
him that one of Capt. Barney's Officers
had some years ago shot the chief Brother
when he was with Capt. Ingram. and that
Mr. Michs expected Capt. Barney would stop here
in a few months on his passage to Canton
and they might have an opportunity of
revenge for Capt. Barney's ship was not
armed back information from Mr. Michs
was false and Malice and very great damage
to us - at 11 a.m. the boat returned
with some gonorr. &c. - took up the boat
and bore away for Canton.
