Mod. & clear — out all  
Reefth —  
at 10 p.m. Sounded in 50  
Fathoms water Bore  
away all the sail

part Mod. & clear —  
Sett all the sail —  
Emp. getting our cables  
aft — the first all in sight  
Lat obs. 14° 44'  
Longt. aut. 113° 50'

At the Courser Mined Thursday January 12th

S.W. E. A.E.  
Strong breeze & clear  
got up T. S. g.c. Mast  
at 10 p.m. in top g.c.  
and lower all sail  
Steadily fresh breeze  
all night — at 6 a.m.  
Set lower all sail —  
The latter part fresh  
breeze and flying clouds  
Emp. on Sunday —  
ships all in sight  
Lat obs. 12° 30'  
Longt. aut. 111° 15'
