At the Course Wind Vatted Jan^y 21st

1 S.W. Light wind and hazy
at 7 p.m. come to anchor
Gasper Island Baring
S.E. N.E. Tree Island S.E. & E
and S.E. point of Banks
S.E. in 15 fathoms water
Light wind all night at
Daylight wind and water
The Master at Noon calm
Let go the anchor 18 fathoms

Lat. 21° 37' Found a current setting to
the S.E. one mile per hour

At the Course Wind Thursday Jan^y 22nd

at 4 p.m. wind with a light
breeze - at 8 calm let
run the anchor 18 fathoms
Water - the Master's part
of Middle Island S.W. N.W.
Calm Gasper S.W. E. & E. & Salt
Island S.W. N.E. -
at daylight wind light
over one boat a head -
at 10 a.m. part Middle Island
Within a quarter of a mile
of a point of the
Ends light and leave

At the Course Wind Monday Jan^y 23rd

at 2 p.m. calm let run
The hodge in 25 fathoms
at 4 p.m. wind - at 8 p.m.
Squally - Middle Island
S.W. E. Salt Island N.W. N.
Middle part light wind
and clear - latter
Part pleasant breeze
all sail set 10 fathoms
Water - two ships in
Company - Lat. 31° 50'

Diff. 34 Miles

At the Course Wind Tuesday Jan^y 24th

1 S.W. S. E. Light wind & clear - all
Sail set - emp. on ship duty
at 8 p.m. in all the sails
Hauled top of sails -
at 11 gone to anchor in
10 fathoms water -
Continual squalls and
rain attended with thunder
and lightning - at 11
S.W. N.W. Wind with a light breeze
Ends light breeze and
hazy - two ships in company
Lat. 41° 44'
