 at 10 light wind from the
 North - Ends the same

Begin with light air -
 of wind & clear -
 at sunset calm saw
 The Eclat at anchor
 at 10 p.m. breeze from the
 North - run through
 between Crooked and
 Tamein Islands -
 at 9 a.m. Squall from

 bearing S. E. B. S. 6 leagues
 off - the Suno in
 company -
