

Saturday Feb 15th 1851
Commenced with moderate breezes
from the N.E. and good weather
Middle part from N.E. Latter
the same so much. Lat by Obs 42° 42'
Long by Chron 8° 50'

Sunday Feb 16th Commenced
with fresh breezes from N.E. and
good weather, at 5 P.M. wind hauled
to the W.S.W. and squally Middle
part light breezes and squally
Latter strong breezes from S.W.
so much. Lat by Obs 44° 18'
Long by Chron 39° 15'

Monday Feb 17th Commenced
with strong breezes from the S.W.
and rugged weather, at 4 P.M. a gale
of wind, Middle part more moderate
Latter light breezes from the south
so much. Lat by Obs 41° 07'
Long by Chron 60° 00'

Tuesday Feb 18th Commenced
with light baffling airs from the
S.W. and good weather Middle part
calm, Latter light breezes from the
North so much. Lat by Obs 44° 48'
Long by Chron 60° 58'

Wednesday Feb 19th Commenced
with moderate breezes from the
N.E. and good weather, Middle
part wind hauled East, Latter
fine breezes and good weather so
much. Lat by Obs 41° 40'
Long by Chron 62° 20'

Thursday Feb 20th Commenced
with fresh breezes from the S.E. and
good weather, Middle part the
same Latter more moderate
so much with thick weather
Lat by Obs 38° 19'
Long by Chron 64° 30'

Friday Feb 21st Commenced
with moderate breezes from the
N.E. and thick weather Middle
part calm and thick foggy Latter
light baffling airs from the
North at 12 foggy lighted so
much. Lat by Obs 38° 19'
Long by Chron 64° 30'

Saturday Feb 22nd 1851
Commenced with light breezes from
the N.E. and good weather Middle
part fresh breezes Latter the same
so much. Lat by Obs 52° 53'
Long by Chron 64° 50'

Sunday Feb 23rd
Commenced with fresh breezes
from the N.E. and good weather
Middle part strong breezes from N.E.
at 5 P.M. saw the Western part of
Statten Land bearing S by E by
Compass about 20 miles dist. Latter
part moderate breezes from the West
and good weather so much. Saw
Island bearing South about 16 miles
dist.

Monday Feb 24th Commenced
with light baffling winds from the
N.E. and good weather, at 8 P.M.
the last end of Statten Land
bore West by Compass about 15 miles
dist, several ships in sight all bound
round Cape Horn Middle part strong
breezes from N.E. and squally at
4 P.M. wind hauled suddenly to
S.W. Latter part strong breezes
from S.W. and squally so much.
Lat by Obs 55° 43'
Long by Chron 65° 49'

Tuesday Feb 25th Commenced
with strong breezes from the S.W.
and squally, at 4 P.M. a gale of
wind ship Harrison bore to heading
S.E. Middle part the same Latter
a little more moderate, wind
West by compass ship heading S.E. and
under double reef foremast, so much
with rain. Lat by Obs 56° 19'
Long by Chron 63° 14'

Wednesday Feb 26th
Commenced with a gale of wind from
N.E. and rain Middle part from
West, Latter the same so much.
Lat by Obs 56° 19'
Long by Chron 63° 14'
