

Thursday June 5th 1857
Commences with moderate breezes
from the S.W. and good weather
Middle part calm latter light baffling
air from the South and thick weather
with a heavy swell running from
the S.E. so ends No Obs.

Friday June 6th Commences
with light baffling air from the
South Easterly and rainy Middle
part baffling air from the S.W.
at 2 A.M. took a heavy squall of
wind and rain from N.E. Latter
part a gale of wind so ends

Long by Obs 178° 10'

Saturday June 7th Commences
with a gale of wind from the
North and cloudy weather Middle
part light baffling air and cloudy
Latter moderate breezes from the
N.E. and rainy saw Black fish
lowered and got 2 so ends

No Obs.

Sunday June 8th
Commences with fresh breezes
from the Eastward and rainy
Middle part a gale of wind Latter
the same so ends Lat by Obs 40° 25'

Monday June 9th Commences
with a gale of wind from the E.S.E.
and rainy Middle and Latter part
the same so ends No Obs.

Tuesday June 10th Commences
with a gale of wind from
the E.S.E. and rainy weather
Middle part wind from the
East Latter from E by S. and
blowing a gale so ends

No Obs.

Wednesday June 11th 1857
Commences with a gale of wind from
the E.S.E. and thick weather Middle
part from N.E. Latter from the North
so ends No Obs.

Thursday June 12th Commences
with a moderate gale of wind from
the North and cloudy weather Middle
part part from N.W. Latter strong
breezes from S.W. and rainy at 9 A.M.
saw several Right Whales, very much
at home, did not lower weather bad,
so ends

No Obs.

Long by Obs 164° 20'

Friday June 13th Commences
with strong breezes from S.W. and
rainy weather Middle part more
moderate with a heavy swell from
the Westward at 8 A.M. saw 2 Whales
lowered and chased Latter part moderate
breezes from the N.W. and a heavy
swell from the S.W. so ends cloudy
weather

Saturday June 14th Commences
with fresh breezes from the N.W. and
cloudy weather Middle part squalls of
fog Latter the same so ends with
strong breezes saw Whales lower and
chased No Obs.

Long by Obs 165° 15'

Sunday June 15th Commences
with strong breezes from the N.W.
and foggy weather Middle part the
same Latter strong breezes and ragged
weather so ends Lat by Obs 46° 52'

Long by Obs 165° 18'

Monday June 16th Commences
with strong breezes from the N.W. and
ragged weather saw 3 Whales going
off to windward Middle part
fresh breezes and cloudy Latter
strong breezes and squalls of fog
so ends Wind W by S.

Lat by Obs 47° 25'
