

Tuesday June 17th 1851
Commences with strong breezes from the
S.W. and thick fog. Middle part
quite moderate, latter light baffling
air from the South and squalls of
fog so ends. Lat by Obs 59° 04'
Long by Obs 174° 10'

Wednesday June 18th Commences
with light baffling air from the
South and squalls of fog. Middle
and latter part the same so
ends. Lat by Obs 58° 18'
Long by Obs 174° 20'

Thursday June 19th Commences
with light baffling air from the
South and clearing weather at 5 P.M.
We saw 2 Whales going quick, lowered and
chased. Middle part light air from
the S.E. Latter light breeze and thick
fog so ends. Lat by Obs

Friday June 20th Commences
with light breezes from the Eastward
and thick fog. Middle part good weather
Latter thick fog again so ends.
Lat by Obs 53° 32'
Long by Obs 175° 00'

Saturday June 21st Commences
with light breezes from the S.E. and
raining at 1 P.M. saw 2 Whales lowered
and chased. Middle part strong breezes
and thick weather. Latter a gale of
wind from the S.E. and raining so
ends. Lat by Obs

Sunday June 22nd Commences
with strong breezes from the S.E.
and thick weather. Middle and latter
part the same so ends. Lat by Obs

Monday June 23rd Commences
with moderate breezes from the South
and thick weather. Middle part wind
from East and sunny. Latter light
baffling air from the S.E. and
calm with thick fog so ends.
Lat by Obs
at 3 P.M. saw 1 Right Whale lowered
and chased

Tuesday June 24th 1851
Commences with light baffling air from
the S.E. and calm with thick fog.
Middle part moderate breezes from
the South. Latter the same with thick
weather so ends. Lat by Obs 57° 07'
Long by Obs 174° 30'

Wednesday June 25th Commences
with fresh breezes from the S.W. and
squalls of fog. Middle part calm
Latter light air from the S.W.
and foggy so ends. Lat by Obs 57° 32'
Long by Obs 175° 20'

Thursday June 26th 1851
Commences with moderate breezes from
the S.W. and squalls of fog & rain.
Middle part calm and thick fog. Latter
the same so ends. Lat by Obs 58° 18'
Long by Obs 176° 30'

Friday June 27th Commences
with light baffling air from the
S.W. and squalls of fog. Middle
part good weather. Latter fine breezes
from the South so ends.

Saturday June 28th Commences
with fine breezes from the S.W. and
good weather at 3 P.M. saw 1 Right
Whale lowered at 3 struck killed and
at 6 took him to the ship, at 8 commenced
cutting at 11 finished. Middle part fresh
breezes. Latter the same at 7 P.M. saw
2 Whales lowered, at 8 struck, held on
about 2 hours 1 boat, line parted the
other Iron broke and lost him saw
more whales lowered struck & killed
so ends just to our whale.



Lat by Obs 60° 34'
Long by Obs 179° 55'
Sunday June 29th Commences
with fresh breezes from the S.W. and
good weather, at 2 P.M. took over whale
to the ship, at 4 commenced cutting at
8 finished. Middle part strong breezes
and thick weather. Latter the same
so ends.
