

Monday June 30th 1851
Commences with strong breezes from the S, S.W. and thick fog, Middle and Latter part the same so ends

Lat by Obs 60° 20'
Long by Obs 174° 10' W

Tuesday July 1st Commences with moderate breezes from the South and foggy, Middle and Latter part fresh breezes and thick weather so ends
No Obs

Wednesday July 2nd Commences with fresh breezes from the South and thick rainy weather Middle part the same Latter squalls of foggy so ends
No Obs

Thursday July 3rd Commences with fresh breezes from the Eastward and foggy Middle part wind from S.E. Latter from the North so ends with cloudy weather and squalls of foggy so ends

Friday July 4th Commences with fresh breezes from the North and cloudy weather Middle, Middle and Latter part the same so ends

Lat by Obs 61° 28'
Long by Obs 178° 13' W

Saturday July 5th Commences with fresh breezes from the North and cloudy weather, Middle part squalls of foggy at 5 P.M. saw the Land, Cape Swain bearing S.W. by S. distant about 40 miles. Latter part light air from the S.W. and good weather so ends

Lat by Obs 61° 58'
Long by Obs 178° 52'

Sunday July 6th Commences with light baffling airs from the S.W. and good weather (Ship) in sight, Middle part light airs from the North with squalls of foggy Latter the same so ends close in with the Ice 7 Ships in sight spoke Ship Champion of New B with 300 bbls part sperm Ship Harriet of do with 300 bbls Bark Harvest of do 380 bbls

Monday July 7th 1851
Commences with light breezes from the North and squalls of foggy Middle part good weather, at 3 P.M. saw 1 Bow Head going quick towards the Land, at 7 P.M. at 8 P.M. struck and drove, Latter fine breezes and good weather, 19 Ships in sight, so ends cruising off Archangel Bay.

Tuesday July 8th Commences with light breezes from the North and good weather, Middle part the same Latter moderate breezes from the N.E. and squalls of foggy so ends

Wednesday July 9th Commences with moderate breezes from the N.E. and cloudy weather, and squalls of foggy, at 5 P.M. spoke the Bark Fortune of S.B. with 300 bbls No 90 of Sperm Oil Middle part a gale of wind from the S.W. Latter the same so ends with thick weather

Thursday July 10th Commences with a gale of wind from the N.E. and thick weather Middle part more moderate Latter moderate breezes and cloudy weather and squalls of foggy so ends

Friday July 11th Commences with moderate breezes from the N.E. and thick weather, Middle part light breezes from the Westward Latter the same with good weather so ends
Lat by Obs 60° 19'
Long by Obs 179° 58'

Saturday July 12th Commences with light baffling breezes from the Westward and thick foggy Middle and Latter part the same so ends

Sunday July 13th Commences with strong breezes from the S.W. and thick weather at 2 P.M. saw a plenty of Ice, at 4 spoke Ship Coral of S.B. 2 Whales, Middle part strong breezes and squalls of foggy, Latter a moderate gale of wind so ends
