

Monday July 14th 1851
Commenced with the moderate gale
of wind from the S.W. and squalls
of fog. Middle part latter part the
same, spoke the Bark Prudent of
Birmingham 2 Whales, so ends the
Land Cape Shadlers bearing West
by Compass about 20 miles dist

Tuesday Thursday July 15th Commenced
with fresh breeze from the Westward and
good weather, Middle part light baffling
air latter the same so ends close
in with the Ice, 2 boats gone in to
look for Whales Cape Shadlers bearing
West by Compass about 20 miles dist

Wednesday July 16th
Commenced with light baffling
air from the S.E. and good weather
Middle and latter part thick fog
so ends

Thursday July 17th Commenced
with moderate breeze from the South
and thick fog Middle part strong
breeze, latter a moderate gale of wind
so ends
Lat 62° 29'
Long 64° 18' to 10'

Friday July 18th Commenced
with a moderate gale of wind from
the South and cloudy weather, Middle
part more moderate and thick fog
latter light baffling air and calm
with thick fog so ends No Obs

Saturday July 19th Commenced
with light baffling air from the North
and thick fog, Middle part the same
latter light breeze and squalls of fog
sun Whales close in with Ice lowered
and hauled 1 Boat went in amongst
the Ice killed 1 Whale come in
thick fog and lost him
so ends Cape Shadlers bearing
S by W by compass about 20
miles dist

Sunday July 20th 1851
Commenced with fine breeze from
the N.E. and squalls of fog, sun
Whales lowered and chased, Middle
part light air from the Westward latter
calm, so ends Cape S. Shadlers
bearing South by Compass about
10 miles dist

Monday July 21st Commenced
with fresh breeze from the South
and good weather sun Whales lowered
and chased, Middle part strong breeze
latter the same with thick weather so
ends the Land & Ice in sight

Tuesday July 22nd Commenced
with strong breeze from the S. by E. and
thick weather Middle part more moderate
with thick weather, latter light breeze
and foggy so ends the Land in sight

Wednesday July 23rd Commenced
with light air from the S.E. and thick
foggy at 7 P.M. spoke Ship D. Webster
of Nantucket 88 months out 407 sh 1200
Whale, Middle part calm, latter
light baffling air from the S.E. and
thick fog so ends Lat by Obs 61° 30' W
in hearing of the breakers

Thursday July 24th
Commenced with light baffling air from
the S.E. and thick fog, Middle part
cloudy weather, latter foggy sun on
Whale lowered and chased so ends
close in with the Land

Friday July 25th Commenced
with light breeze from the S.E. and
foggy weather, Middle part calm and
thick fog latter the same so
ends

Saturday July 26th Commenced
with light baffling air from the
S.E. and thick fog, Middle part light
air from the S.E. and thick fog, latter
light air from the S.E. and thick
fog so ends No Obs
