

Thursday August 21st 1857
Commences with slight baffling air
from the S. S. W. and good weather
at 2 P. M. Whales going quick to the
S. W. and chased Middle part
strong breeze from the S. S. W. and rainy,
at 5 P. M. better weather, saw 1 whale
lowered at 6 struck killed, at 12 took
him to the ship, so ends with
moderate breeze from the S. S. W.
and a bad swell from S. E.

Lat by account 53° 20'
Long by Id. 162° 10'

Friday August 22nd Commences
with moderate breeze from the
S. W. and thick weather, rain storm
Middle part the same, latter light
breeze from the W. S. W. and good
weather, at 5 P. M. saw the Land Cape
Chipounskoy bearing N. by E. by compass
about 40 miles dist. Lat by Id. 53° 08'
Long by Id. 161° 40'

Saturday August 23rd
Commences with light breeze from the
W. S. W. and good weather, Middle part
strong breeze from the North and squally
latter light baffling air from all
points of the compass and squalls
of rain, so ends. The Land in sight
about 40 miles dist bearing N. by E.

Sunday August 24th Commences
with light baffling air from North
and squalls of rain Middle part strong
gale from the North with heavy showers of
rain and hail, latter more moderate
with fine weather so ends. Lat by Id. 52° 26'
2 ships in sight the Land about 45 miles
dist

Monday August 25th Commences
with strong breeze from the N. S. W. and
good weather at 1 P. M. spoke Ship Hornok
of Chalmers & Son out 780 lbs sperm oil
Middle part light air from the S. W.
latter strong breeze from the south
so ends. The Land bearing N. by E. about
50 miles dist

Tuesday August 26th 1857
Commences with strong breeze from the
S. S. W. and rainy weather Middle part
the same, latter moderate breeze from
the W. S. W. and thick weather so ends
Lat by Id. 52° 34'

Wednesday August 27th
Commences with fresh breeze from the
W. S. W. and squalls of fog & rain, Middle
part strong breeze from the N. S. W.
latter moderate breeze from the N. S. W.
so ends with a bad swell from the
North
Lat by Id. 52° 23'
Long by Id. 162° 18'

Thursday August 28th Commences
with light baffling air from the N. S. W.
and good weather, Middle part light
breeze from the North, latter light breeze
from the N. S. W. so ends the Land in sight
Lat by Id. 52° 21'
Long by Id. 161° 22'

Friday August 29th Commences
with light breeze from the N. S. W. and
good weather Middle part the same so
ends close in with the Land Cape
Chipounskoy bearing N. by E. about 40
miles dist Lat by Id. 52° 32'

Saturday August 30th Commences
with fine breeze from the S. W.
and good weather, close in to the
Land a great number of Hornbacks
in sight but no R. Whales, Middle
part strong breeze from the N. S. W.
latter moderate breeze from the
North so ends close in with the Land
so ends

Sunday August 31st
Commences with slight baffling
winds from the N. S. W. and
good weather at 1 P. M. saw 3 R.
Whales lowered and chased Middle
part light breeze from the S. W.
latter light baffling air from
the N. S. W. so ends close in with
the Land Cape Chipounskoy bearing
N. by E. about 50 miles dist
