

Monday Sept 1<sup>st</sup> 1831  
Commences with light baffling air  
from the Eastward and good weather  
Middle part moderate breeze from the  
South, latter fresh breeze, saw 1 whale  
lower and chased, spoke ship, Cape  
Delanoy of Chirhagen 38 months out  
800 lbs sperm & 2 J. Whales so ends  
with cloudy weather the Land in sight  
Lat by Obs 52° 37'

Tuesday Sept 2<sup>nd</sup> Commences  
with fresh breeze from the S.E. and  
cloudy weather, Middle part a gale  
of wind rain latter a gale of wind  
from S.E. with rain so ends  
Lat by Obs 52° 40'

Wednesday Sept 3<sup>rd</sup> Commences  
with a gale of wind from the S.E. and  
rainy, Middle part light baffling air  
and thick weather, latter light air  
from the South and good weather  
so ends close in with the Land  
Lat by Obs 52° 46'

Thursday Sept 4<sup>th</sup> Commences  
with light baffling winds from the  
South Westward and good weather Middle  
and latter part the same so ends  
close in with the Land 2 ships in sight  
1 cutting Lat by Obs 52° 35'

Friday Sept 5<sup>th</sup> Commences  
with moderate breezes from the S.E. and  
occasional fog, Middle part thick  
fog, latter the same until 11 A.M. then  
good weather so ends  
Lat by Obs 52° 32'

Saturday Sept 6<sup>th</sup> Commences  
with light baffling air from the Westward  
and good weather spoke ship William  
Hompson of Bedford 900 lbs, Middle  
part fresh breeze, latter light baffling air and  
calm so ends close in with the Land  
Lat by Obs 52° 15'

Sunday Sept 7<sup>th</sup> Commences  
with light baffling air from the S.W. and  
cloudy weather, Middle part a gale of wind  
latter the same so ends close  
in with the Land Lat by Obs 52° 28'

Monday Sept 8<sup>th</sup> 1831  
Commences with strong breeze from the  
S.W. and cloudy weather Middle part  
the same, latter moderate breeze  
from the Eastward so ends, the Land  
about 13 miles dist Lat by Obs 52° 46'

Tuesday Sept 9<sup>th</sup> Commences  
with light baffling air from the  
Eastward and good weather, spoke the  
French ship Ferdinand no oil this  
season, Middle part light baffling air  
from the South latter the same  
so ends Lat by Obs 52° 40'

Wednesday Sept 10<sup>th</sup> Commences  
with light baffling air from the South  
and cloudy weather, Middle and latter  
part the same so ends close in with  
the Land

Thursday Sept 11<sup>th</sup> Commences  
with moderate breeze from the S.W.  
and cloudy weather with P.M. spoke  
ship Anchor nothing this season  
but the oil she took out of the hold,  
Middle part the same, latter light  
breeze so ends the Land Lat by Obs 52° 46'

Friday Sept 12<sup>th</sup> Commences  
with fine breeze from the S.W. and  
hazy weather, Middle and latter part  
the same so ends close in with  
the Land Lat by Obs 53° 32'

Saturday Sept 13<sup>th</sup> Commences  
with fresh breeze from the S.W. and  
hazy weather, Middle part the same  
latter thick fog light breeze from  
the Eastward so ends Lat by Obs 53° 32'

Sunday Sept 14<sup>th</sup> Commences  
with strong breeze from the S.W. and  
thick rainy weather Middle part  
the same latter fresh breeze and  
good weather so ends Cape Chipman  
sighted bearing P.M. by compass  
about 12 miles dist Lat by Obs 52° 49'
