

Sunday Nov 23rd 1837
Commenced with light breezes from
the eastward and good weather, Middle
and Latter part the same so ends

Lat by Obs 20° 33'
Long by Obs 156° 35'

Monday Nov 24th Commenced
with light baffling airs from the S.E.
and good weather, Middle part light
airs from the Eastward Latter the
same so ends

Lat by Obs 20° 40'
Long by Obs 158° 00'

Tuesday Nov 25th Commenced
with light baffling airs from the Eastward
and good weather, Middle part fine
breezes, Latter quite moderate again
at 5 P.M. saw the Island of Pensacola
bearing N.W. by compass about
30 miles dist. so ends Sailing for
the Island

Wednesday Nov 26th Commenced
with light breezes from the S.E. and
good weather at 3 P.M. close in
with the Land, Middle part moderate
breezes and good weather Latter the
same so ends Laying off and on
getting recruits from the shore

Thursday Nov 27th Commenced
with moderate breezes from the Eastward
and good weather Middle and Latter
part the same so ends Laying off
and on getting recruits from the
shore at 12 got all on board, but
waiting for 2 Men that deserted

Friday Nov 28th Commenced
with moderate breezes from the Eastward
and good weather, Middle and Latter
part the same, Laying off waiting
for deserters so ends

Saturday Nov 29th Commenced
with moderate breezes from the Eastward
and good weather, at 4 P.M. the natives brought
out 2 deserters on board, at 6 left
the Island Middle part cloudy weather
Latter the same so ends

Lat by Obs 22° 32'

Sunday Nov 30th 1837
Commenced with moderate breezes
from the Eastward and cloudy weather
Middle part the same, Latter squally
at 9 A.M. saw a shoal of sperm whales
lowered at 11 struck got 1 boat stove and
drowned from the whale, so ends with
thick rainy weather No Obs

Monday Dec 1st Commenced
with moderate breezes from the South
and heavy showers of rain, Middle
part fresh breezes from the Eastward and
squally Latter moderate breezes and
good weather so ends

Lat by Obs 23° 26'
Long by Obs 160° 34'

Tuesday Dec 2nd Commenced
with light breezes from the Eastward
and good weather at 3 P.M. saw several
large sperm whales, lowered and at
8 P.M. struck, held on until dark
then cut, Middle part light baffling
airs from the Eastward Latter fresh
breezes from the South and squally
so ends

Lat by Obs 23° 40'
Long by Obs 160° 32'

Wednesday Dec 3rd Commenced
with strong breezes from the South
and overcast weather, Middle part
good weather Latter the same
so ends

Lat by Obs 23° 24'
Long by Obs 160° 32'

Thursday Dec 4th Commenced
with fine breezes from the Eastward
and good weather, Middle and Latter
part the same so ends

Lat by Obs 23° 13'
Long by Obs 159° 48'

Friday Dec 5th Commenced
with fine breezes from the Eastward
and good weather, Middle part the
same, Latter cloudy weather so
ends

Lat by Obs 23° 36'
Long by Obs 159° 58'
