

Saturday Dec 20th 1851
Commences with strong breeze from
the S.W. and good weather Middle
part a gale of wind with rain Latter
the same So ends No Obs

Sunday Dec 21st Commences
with a moderate gale of wind from
the S.W. and rainy, Middle part the
same Latter more moderate with
good weather So ends Lat by Obs 46° 23'
Long by Obs 152° 55'

Monday Dec 22nd Commences
with fresh breeze from the S.W.
and good weather, Middle part a
gale of wind Latter the same on
ends with cloudy No Obs

Tuesday Dec 23rd Commences
with a gale of wind from the North
and squally weather Middle part
rainy, Latter quite moderate with
the wind from the North and showers
of rain So ends No Obs

Wednesday Dec 24th Commences
with light baffling winds from the
S.E. and rain, Middle part rain
from N.E. and thick fog Latter the
same So ends No Obs

Thursday Dec 25th Commences
with fine breeze from the S.W. and
thick weather, Middle part the same
Latter fine breeze from the North with
squalls of fog, at 7 A.M. saw one
right whale at 8 lowered and the
boatswain missed him, So ends
with thick weather Lat by Obs 47° 32'
Long by Obs 152° 18'

Friday Dec 26th Commences
with moderate breeze from the North
and foggy, Middle part light baffling
winds from the Westward and foggy
Latter light baffling air from the
South and calm So ends
Lat by Obs 47° 29'
Long by Obs 152° 00'

Saturday Dec 27th 1851
Commences with light baffling air
from the South and calm Middle
part light breeze from the Westward,
Latter fresh breeze, at 9 A.M. saw one
whale lowered, struck, and the line
got cut and then parted, So ends
with strong breeze Lat by Obs 47° 57'
Long by Obs 152° 00'

Sunday Dec 28th Commences
with strong breeze from the Westward
and foggy weather, at 4 P.M. saw
1 whale going quick to windward
did not lower, Middle part a moderate
gale of wind with showers of rain, Latter
strong breeze and squally So ends
Lat by Obs 47° 58'
Long by Obs 152° 12'

Monday Dec 29th Commences
with strong breeze from the Westward
and foggy weather, Middle part
a gale of wind from N.W. Latter the
same with rain So ends
No Obs

Tuesday Dec 30th Commences
with a gale of wind from the N.W. and
rainy, Middle part the same, Latter
a moderate gale and good weather So
ends Lat by Obs 48° 11'
Long by Obs 151° 45'

Wednesday Dec 31st Commences
with a gale of wind from the
N.W. and squally weather, Middle
part more moderate Latter strong
breeze and good weather, So ends
Lat by Obs 48° 29'
Long by Obs 150° 40'

Thursday Jan 1st 1852
Commences with strong breeze
from the S.W. and squally
weather, Middle part the same
Latter more moderate with
a heavy swell from the S.W.
So ends saw 1 whale lowered
and started at him

Lat by Obs 47° 48'
Long by Obs 150° 06'
