

Friday Jan 2nd 1852
Commences with fresh breezes from
the S.W. and squally weather, with a
heavy swell from the Westward, at
2 P.M. saw Whales, lowered, struck got
1 boat stove and 1 man hurt then
cut the line, Middle part moderate
breezes, latter strong breezes and squally
saw Whales lowered and chased so
ends
Lat by Obs 47° 28'
Long by Obs 130° 30'

Saturday Jan 3rd Commences
with strong breezes from the Westward and
squally weather, Middle part a moderate
gale of wind, latter strong breezes
and squally saw Whales lowered
and chased so ends, Lat by Obs 47° 45'
Long by Obs 130° 40'

Sunday Jan 4th Commences
with strong breezes from the Westward
and cloudy weather, saw Whales
lowered and struck 1 the Iron broke
and lost him, Middle part a gale
of wind, latter the same so ends
Lat by Obs 47° 57'
Long by Obs 130° 48'

Monday Jan 5th Commences
with a gale of wind from the Westward
and squally weather, Middle and
latter part the same so ends
Lat by Obs 47° 22'
Long by Obs 130° 31'

Tuesday Jan 6th Commences
with strong breezes from S.W. and
squally weather, saw Whales, lowered
and chased, Middle part quite moderate
latter fine breezes, and good weather
at 1 P.M. saw Whales lowered at 8
struck killed and at 11 took me
to the ship so ends, Lat by Obs 47° 24'
Long by Obs 130° 50'

Wednesday Jan 7th Commences
with moderate breezes from the S.W.
and good weather, Middle part the
same, latter a gale of wind from the
S.W. and showers of rain
so ends
No Obs

Thursday Jan 8th 1852
Commences with a gale of wind
from the S.W. and rainy, Middle
and latter part the same so ends
Lat by Obs 47° 40'

Friday Jan 9th Commences
with a gale of wind from the S.W.
and rainy, Middle part from S.W.
and rainy, latter strong breezes and good
weather so ends, steering so the Eastward
Lat by Obs 46° 57'
Long by Obs 147° 30'

Saturday Jan 10th Commences
with a gale of wind from the Westward
and squally weather, Middle part strong
breezes, latter the same so ends, Lat by Obs 45° 54'
Long by Obs 145° 50'

Sunday Jan 11th Commences
with strong breezes from the Westward and
squally weather, Middle part the same
latter a gale of wind, at 8 A.M. saw
1 right, Lat by sailing so ends
Lat by Obs 44° 40'
Long by Obs 141° 50'

Monday Jan 12th Commences
with a gale of wind from the Westward
and squally weather, at 3 P.M. a
heavy sea boarded the ship and
broke the Waist Boat down, Middle
part moderate breezes, latter quite
moderate and thick weather so
ends
No Obs

Tuesday Jan 13th Commences
with light baffling winds from the
Westward and thick weather, Middle
part the same, latter fine breezes
from the North and cloudy weather
so ends
Lat by Obs 43° 38'
Long by Obs 136° 58'

Wednesday Jan 14th Commences
with fresh breezes from the North and
cloudy weather, Middle part fresh
breezes from the Westward and thick
weather, latter the same so ends
Lat by Obs 43° 08'
Long by Obs 133° 10'
