

Tuesday March 1st 1853
Commences with a gale of wind
from the Eastward and squally
weather Middle part strong Trades
and squally latter the same so much

Wednesday March 2nd Commences
with strong Trades and squally weather
and latter part the same so much

Thursday March 3rd Commences
with strong Trades and squally weather
part more moderate latter the same
so much

Friday March 4th Commences
with fine Trades and squally weather
Middle and latter part good weather
so much

Saturday March 5th Commences
with fine Trades and good weather
Middle and latter part the same
so much

Sunday March 6th Commences
with fine Trades and good weather
Middle and latter part the same
so much

Monday March 7th Commences
with fine Trades and good weather
Middle part the same at 5 P.M. saw
the land the S.E. part of Owyhee bearing
W by compass about 15 miles distant
at 8 took a Pilot at 9 12 came to anchor
at Hilo in 5 fathoms water

1853
Wednesday March 30th
Commences with strong breeze from the
N.E. and squally Middle part more
moderate at 9 P.M. weighed anchor
made sail for sea at 12, bearing out
so much with moderate breeze and good
weather

Thursday March 31st
Commences with light breeze from
the N.E. and good weather at 11 P.M.
got out clear of the land bound for
Honolulu latter part fresh breeze
and squally so much Honolulu bearing
East part South by compass about 15
miles distant

Friday April 1st Commences
with fresh breeze from the Eastward
and good weather at 7 P.M. came in
so the passage between Mookie and
Molokai at 10 laying aback waiting
for daylight at 7 P.M. wind on shore
latter light breeze from the Eastward
so much laying off from at Mookie

Saturday March 2nd Commences
with breeze from the Eastward and good
weather at 4 P.M. came on board
with Mr. Hume the 1st mate who
had been on shore since the 3rd of
last Oct. and took on board Mr. Crutcher
that I have just shipped 4th mate for
the next cruise at 5 left for Oahu
Middle part light baffling air and
calm at 7 P.M. light breeze from the
Eastward, latter light breeze and good
weather so much between Molokai and
Honolulu

Sunday March 3rd Commences
with light baffling wind from the
Eastward and good weather Middle
part moderate breeze from the N.E.
latter the same so much the
Eastward part of Oahu bearing
North by compass about 10 miles
distant
