

Monday May 30th 1853
Commenced with strong breeze from
the Eastward and squalls of snow at
1 P.M. spoke three mountains of ice
South of 52° Spence, Middle part most modern
Latter fresh breeze and some snow so
ends

Tuesday May 31st Commenced
with moderate breeze from the S.E. and
good weather, Middle part the same
Latter light breeze from the S.W. and
fine weather close in with the ice
and ice rubbing sounds

Wednesday June 1st Commenced
with light breeze from the S.W. and
good weather, Middle part the same
Latter moderate breeze from West and
fine weather so ends close in with the
ice

Thursday June 2nd Commenced
with moderate breeze from the Westward
and good weather saw 1 Whale brown and
chased, spoke dark colored sheep 1 Whale
Middle light breeze and latter the same
so ends

Friday June 3rd Commenced
with moderate breeze from the
Westward and good weather Middle
and latter part the same so ends
saw 2 Whales brown and chased

Saturday June 4th Commenced
with light breeze from the
Westward and good weather saw 2 Whales
brown and chased Middle part thick foggy
Latter the same so ends

Sunday June 5th Commenced
with light baffling breeze from the Eastward
and foggy Middle part the same
at 1 P.M. foggy lighted at 4 and
Whales brown and chased in
company with ship, numbers of
Chauvin the saw 2 Whales so
ends with cloudy weather and squalls of fog

Monday June 6th 1853
Commenced with fresh breeze from S.E.
and foggy Middle part the same
at 1 P.M. wind from the Westward foggy
lighted Latter fine breeze and cloudy
weather so ends close in with the
ice

Tuesday June 7th Commenced
with fresh breeze from the Westward and
cloudy weather saw several Whales
going very quick to Westward toward
and chased Middle part close in with the
ice at 1 P.M. saw Whales at 7 came in thick
foggy and continued so through the day
so ends

Wednesday June 8th Commenced
with light breeze from the Westward and
thick foggy weather Middle part foggy
lighted Latter light breeze and cloudy
weather so ends

Thursday June 9th Commenced
with light breeze from the S.W. and
cloudy weather Middle part light air
and foggy Latter the same so ends

Friday June 10th Commenced
with light baffling breeze from the S.E.
and foggy Middle part wind from the
West Latter the same and foggy so
ends

Saturday June 11th Commenced
with fresh breeze from the S.W. and thin
foggy Middle part thick foggy Latter better
weather so ends

Sunday June 12th Commenced
with with light baffling breeze from S.E.
and heavy weather Middle part foggy
at 1 P.M. saw the Cape Oliver bearing
W. by N. distant about 12 miles distant the Cape
and haze weather so ends

Monday June 13th Commenced
with light breeze from the S.W. and heavy
weather Middle part the same Latter thick
foggy so ends spoke an long high bank
with 2 Whales
