

Tuesday June 14th 1853
Commenced with moderate breeze from
the S.W. and thick foggy weather
and latter part the same so ends

Wednesday June 15th Commenced
with moderate breeze from the S.W. and
thick foggy weather and latter part
wind from the N.W. and same with
thick foggy weather

Thursday June 16th Commenced
with moderate breeze from the S.W. and
thick foggy weather and latter part
light 10 Whales, Middle part - Squalls
of foggy, latter thick foggy so ends
close in with the Ice

Friday June 17th Commenced
with fair breeze from the S.W. and
thick foggy at 2 P.M. foggy light
saw Whales, some struck and at
4 o'clock took one to the ship Middle
part foggy, latter the same so ends
saw dead whale in night

Saturday June 18th
Commenced with light breeze from
the S.W. and thick weather at 1 P.M.
took the one whale to the ship that we
saw before dinner and commenced
cutting and finished saw one other
dead whale at 1 took him alongside
Middle part fresh breeze and foggy, latter
quite moderate with squalls of foggy

Sunday June 19th Commenced
with light baffling breeze from the East
in squalls foggy Middle Middle part
light breeze from the S.W. latter
the same with good weather so
ends, 20 Whales in sight also the
Land Cape Cove bearing about
about 55 miles dist

Monday June 20th 1853
Commenced with light baffling breeze
from the Westward and good weather
Middle part moderate breeze from
S.W. latter the same so ends

Tuesday June 21st Commenced
with moderate breeze from the S.W. and
good weather, Middle part light
breeze from the Westward and foggy, latter
wind from S.W. and squalls of foggy so
ends

Wednesday June 22nd Commenced
with fresh breeze from the S.W. and foggy
Middle part good weather latter fresh breeze
from the S.W. and squalls of foggy so
ends

Long 158° 00'

Thursday June 23rd Commenced
with fresh breeze from the S.W. and
good weather, Middle part wind from
S.W. latter the same with good
weather so ends

Lat 54° 37' 45"
Long 158° 00'

Friday June 24th Commenced
with light breeze from the S.W. and
good weather, Middle part calm
latter light breeze from the S.W. and
cloudy weather so ends

Saturday June 25th Commenced
with light baffling breeze from the Eastward
and cloudy weather the Land Cape Cove
bearing N by E by compass about 20 miles
dist Middle part light breeze from the S.W.
at 1 P.M. close in to the Island in the
mouth of the Gulf of Davis, latter
part fresh breeze from the S.W. and
good weather at 12 o'clock to the Gulf so
ends

Sunday June 26th Commenced
with fresh breeze from the Westward
and good weather, Middle part baffling
latter light breeze from the S.W.
so ends with thin foggy close
in with the Land
