

Monday June 27th 1853
Commenced with light baffling winds
from the South and foggy. Spoke the
Ship Barclay of San Pedro & Whaler
Middle part light breeze, Latter strong
breeze from the S.E. by E. and foggy
so only heading out of the Gulf at
12 got out

Tuesday June 28th Commenced
with a gale of wind from the S.E. by E.
and rainy, Middle part the same
Latter more moderate so only heading
out of the Gulf

Wednesday June 29th
Commenced with strong breeze from
the S.E. and rainy, Middle part calm
Latter light baffling air from the S.E.
so only with thick rainy weather

Thursday June 30th Commenced
with light baffling air from the S.E.
and thick weather, Middle and Latter
part the same so only

Friday July 1st Commenced
with fresh breeze from the S.E. and
good weather at 4 P.M. spoke the Ship
Squire of San Pedro & Whaler
Middle part light breeze Latter the
same with squalls of fog so only

Saturday July 2nd Commenced
with light baffling winds from the
S.E. and good weather, Middle
part fresh breeze from the S.E. Latter
from E.S.E. and rainy so only spoke
the Ship Hunter of San Pedro & Whaler

Sunday July 3rd Commenced
with strong breeze from the Eastward
and a rain storm, Middle part quite
moderate and showers of rain
Latter light baffling air from
all points of compass and calm
so only with cloudy weather

Monday July 4th 1853
Commenced with light baffling air
from the South and cloudy weather
Middle part the same Latter foggy at
11 o'clock. I saw the Shander Island bearing
S.W. by W. compass about 25 miles dist

Tuesday July 5th Commenced
with moderate breeze from the S.E.
and good weather, Middle part the same
close in to the Island at 1 o'clock. Boat went
in to the Ice at 8 found a dead whale
at 10 took him to the Ship, Latter light
baffling air and good weather so only
the Island bearing S.W. about 1 mile
dist

Wednesday July 6th Commenced
with light baffling air from the Westward
and squalls of fog, close in to the
Island. Middle part the same, Latter
quite foggy spoke the Bark Concordia
of Sugar Harbor, so only about 3 miles
from Great Shander Island

Thursday July 7th Commenced
with light baffling air from the
S.W. and thick weather, Middle
part a gale of wind with rain, Latter
foggy so only close in with Land &
Ice

Friday July 8th Commenced
with fresh breeze from the Westward
and good weather, Middle part the same
Latter moderate breeze from the South
so only saw Whales, bowries and chaps

Saturday July 9th Commenced
with moderate breeze from the South
and good weather, Middle part foggy
Latter thick fog so only

Sunday July 10th Commenced
with light baffling winds from the
Eastward and thick fog, Middle part
wind from S.E. and thick fog
Latter the same so only
