

Monday July 11th 1853.
Commences with light baffling winds
from the S. E. and thick foggy Middle
and Latter part the same so ends

Tuesday July 12th Commences
with moderate breeze from the S. E.
and foggy thick weather Middle
part the same Latter better
weather so ends close in with the
Land

Wednesday July 13th Commences
with light breeze from the S. E. and
good weather close in with
the Ice, Middle part calm, Latter light
baffling winds from the Eastward so ends
close in with the Land & Ice

Thursday July 14th Commences
with fine breeze from the S. E. and good
weather, Middle part fine breeze from
the S. E. Latter fresh breeze at 5 P.M.
saw Whales lowered struck killed, came
in thick fog, the Whales ran in to
the Ice and turned up boats came
on board the fog lifted found
the Whales again and at 10 took him
to the ship and at 11 commenced
beating so ends

Friday July 15th Commences
with light breeze from the S. E. and
hazy weather, Middle part thick fog,
Latter appears of foggy so ends close in
with the Ice

Saturday July 16th Commences
with moderate breeze from the S. E. and
foggy weather, Middle part thick fog,
Latter the same so ends saw Whales
lowered and chased

Sunday July 17th Commences
with light baffling winds from the
Eastward and foggy Middle part the
same Latter fog lifted saw
Whales lowered and chased so ends
close by the Ice and Land

Monday July 18th 1853
Commences with light breeze from the
South and good weather, Middle part
light baffling winds from the Westward
Latter the same so ends saw plenty
of Whales but could not get fast
close in with the Ice

Tuesday July 19th Commences
with light baffling winds from the
Eastward and good weather at 8 P.M.
thick foggy Middle and Latter part
the same so ends

Wednesday July 20th Commences
with light baffling winds from the South
and speaks of foggy Middle part good
weather Latter the same saw Whales
lowered struck and 12 took on to the
Ship so ends close in with the Ice
and Land

Thursday July 21st Commences
with strong breeze from the
South and good weather Middle
part light air and calm at 4 P.M.
boats went in to the Ice at 9 P.M.
and killed one Whale and commenced
towing so ends with light air and
calm

Friday July 22nd Commences
with light baffling winds and calm
at 1 P.M. got our Whales to the Ship
Middle part foggy Latter light
showers of rain so ends

Saturday July 23rd Commences
with light baffling winds and speaks
of foggy Middle part good weather
Latter fresh breeze from the Westward
so ends close in with the Ice and Land
2 boats gone in for Whales

Sunday July 24th Commences
with light breeze from the Westward and
good weather, spoke this boat 11 Whales &
the Whales saw 11 to Middle part strong
breeze Latter thick weather so ends
