

Monday Aug 3<sup>rd</sup> 1853  
Commenced with moderate breezes  
from the S.W. and squally weather  
saw Whales lowered truck and drawn  
Middle part light breezes. Latter the  
same saw Whales lowered at 9 o'clock  
at 11 killed the 1st about 8 miles  
from the ship so only with a dead  
cabin

Tuesday Aug 4<sup>th</sup> Commenced  
with light baffling winds and calms at 5  
P.M. got our Whales to the ship Middle  
part quite moderate breezes from  
the S.W. Latter strong breezes and  
thick weather so will close in with  
the land

Wednesday Aug 5<sup>th</sup> Commenced  
with a gale of wind from the S.W.  
and thick weather, Middle part heavy  
gales Latter the same with showers  
of rain so will close in with the land

Thursday Aug 6<sup>th</sup> Commenced  
with a gale of wind from the S.W. and  
cloudy weather, Middle part the same  
Latter thick and rainy and a moderate  
gale so will

Friday Aug 7<sup>th</sup> Commenced  
with a gale of wind from the S.W. and  
thick weather, Middle part rainy  
Latter quite moderate with thick  
fog so will

Saturday Aug 8<sup>th</sup> Commenced  
with fresh breeze from the S.W. and  
good weather, spoke ship Canada  
Wood Bts. Middle part strong breezes  
from the S.W. Latter from the S.W. saw  
Whales lowered struck killed and at  
11 took one for the ship so only  
about 5 miles from the land

Sunday Aug 9<sup>th</sup> Commenced  
with light breezes from thick  
and good weather, Middle part light  
baffling winds and calm at 4 o'clock saw  
Whales lowered struck and at 10 took  
one for the ship Latter light breezes  
from the South so will

Monday Aug 15<sup>th</sup> 1853  
Commenced with light baffling winds  
from the South and good weather  
Middle part fresh breezes from the S.W.  
Latter more moderate so will with  
a heavy swell from the S.W.

Tuesday Aug 16<sup>th</sup> Commenced  
with light breeze from the S.W. and  
thick weather, Middle part fresh  
breezes from the S.W. and cloudy weather  
Latter the same so will close in  
with the land

Wednesday Aug 17<sup>th</sup> Commenced  
with light baffling winds from the  
S.W. and cloudy weather, Middle part  
baffling winds and thick weather Latter  
the same so will

Thursday Aug 18<sup>th</sup> Commenced  
with baffling winds from the Eastward and  
a heavy swell heaving from the S.W.  
Middle part the same Latter strong  
breezes so will close in with the land

Friday Aug 19<sup>th</sup> Commenced  
with fresh breeze from the Eastward and  
dark cloudy weather, Middle part  
a gale of wind Latter the same so  
will with a very bad sea from the  
Eastward

Saturday Aug 20<sup>th</sup> Commenced  
with fresh breeze from the S.W. and  
a heavy swell heaving from the  
Eastward, Middle part light baffling  
winds from the S.W. Latter the same  
so will employed in starting the  
land about 15 miles distant

Sunday Aug 21<sup>st</sup> Commenced  
with light baffling winds from the  
South and good weather, Middle  
part the same at 5 P.M. saw close  
in with the land wind commenced  
blowing from the S.W. with rain at  
9 a gale of wind Latter the  
same so will
