

Monday Aug 22nd 1853
Commences with a gale of wind from
the S.E. and rainy Middle part the
same latter better weather so
ends close in with the Land but
saw nothing

Tuesday Aug 23rd Commences
with light breeze from the S.E.
and good weather, Middle part
foggy latter part squalls of foggy
clouds saw nothing

Wednesday Aug 24th Commences
with light baffling winds from the
S.E. and cloudy haze weather, Middle
part calm with thick fog and rain
latter squalls of foggy so ends close in
with the Land and saw nothing

Thursday Aug 25th Commences
with fresh breeze from the Eastward
and cloudy thick weather, Middle
part thick and rainy, at 10 o'clock wind
bowed to the Westward and good weather
so ends close in with the Land and saw
nothing.

Friday Aug 26th Commences
with fresh breeze from the S.E. and
good weather, spotted ship R.
Hon. Sh. B. bound in, Middle part
squally latter baffling wind with
rain so ends close in with the Land

Saturday Aug 27th Commences
with light baffling winds and calms with
a plenty of rain at 9 o'clock, came to anchor
in 11 fathoms water, at 5 o'clock took our
Anchor at 11 saw a dead whale at 7 took
him to the ship blowing strong so ragged
so cut with a strong line and a line
saw towing our whale under the lee of
the Land

Sunday Aug 28th Commences
with strong breeze from the S.E. and a
bad sea we cut in our whale, lost the
head, Middle part strong breeze
latter the same saw whales
conced and chase so ends close in
with the Land

Monday Aug 29th Commences
with strong breeze from the S.E. and
ragged weather, Middle part gale of
wind latter the same so ends close
in with the Land

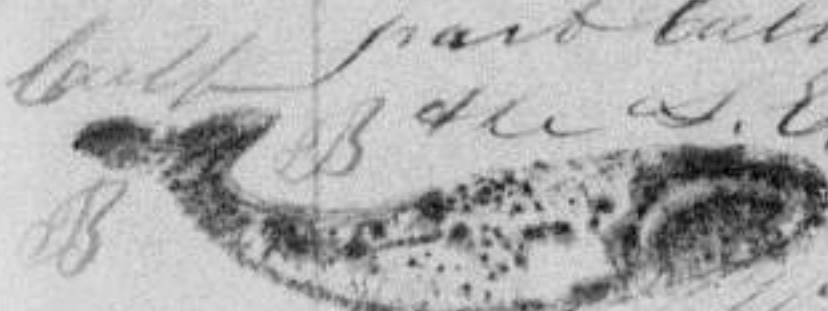
Tuesday Aug 30th Commences
with strong breeze from the S.E. and
good weather at 1 o'clock, came to anchor
at Pickles Island in 6 fathoms
water, Middle part a gale of wind latter
the same so ends laying at anchor

Wednesday Aug 31st Commences
with fresh breeze from the Westward
and good weather, Middle part quite
moderate latter the same laying at
anchor getting more and water seen
early

Thursday Sept 1st Commences
with light baffling winds from the
all points of the compass, and good
weather at 6 o'clock finished getting
out of water, Middle part calm at 10 o'clock
light baffling winds, made sail at 8
covered for whale at 9 struck him and
at 10 took one to the ship latter light
breeze from the S.E. and good weather



Friday Sept 2nd Commences
with light breeze from the S.E. and
good weather at 5 o'clock struck a
whale at 6 took him to the ship, Middle
part calm latter moderate breeze from
the S.E. at 10 o'clock struck and killed a whale
latter good weather so ends towing
our whale



Saturday Sept 3rd Commences
with light baffling winds from the
S.E. and good weather at 4 o'clock got one
whale to the ship, Middle part fresh
breeze from S.E. at 8 o'clock got our
other whale along side of ship
for the Harbour at 12 came to
Anchor in 6 fathoms water and
60 fathoms then finished cutting
our whale
