

Thursday Sept 18th 1853
Commenced with strong breezes from
the N. W. and cloudy sick weather
Middle part the same. Latter wind
from S. W. and quite moderate so
ends

Friday Sept 19th Commenced
with light breezes from the S. W. and
good weather, Middle part calm
with light breezes from the South
ends

Saturday Sept 20th Commenced
with fresh breezes from the Westward
and good weather, Middle part the
same. Latter wind S. W. and squally
so ends

Sunday Sept 21st Commenced
with strong breezes from the S. W. and
good weather, Middle part quite moderate
at 10 P. M. saw the Island of Makuraka
bearing S. E. by compass about 20 miles
dist at 12 saw Sumner's Peak, and Oukotani
at 7 P. M. in the passage between the
Islands. Latter light breezes from S. E.
and thick and rainy, at 12 out of the
Ochotik Sea so ends with plenty
of rain

Monday Sept 22nd Commenced
with baffling winds from the South
East with rain at 2 P. M. fresh
breezes from S. E. Middle part
more moderate. Latter light baffling
winds from the Westward and thick fog
so ends

Tuesday Sept 23rd Commenced
with light baffling winds from the South
and squally foggy, Middle part
the same, Latter light breezes from
S. E. and good weather so ends

Wednesday Sept 24th 1853
Commenced with light breezes from the
S. E. and cloudy weather, Middle part
wind from S. E. Latter the same
so ends with thick weather

Thursday Sept 25th Commenced
with fresh breezes from the Eastward and
rainy, Middle part wind to the North
Latter light breezes from the S. E. and
good weather so ends

Friday Sept 26th Commenced
with light baffling winds from S. E. and
good weather, Middle part moderate
breezes from S. W. Latter the same so
ends

Saturday Sept 27th Commenced
with moderate breezes from S. E. and
cloudy weather, Middle part strong
breezes from S. E. Latter a gale of wind
from East with plenty of rain so
ends

Sunday Sept 28th Commenced
with a gale of wind from the Eastward
and rainy, Middle part a heavy gale
from S. W. Latter part the same so
ends with squally weather

Monday Sept 29th Commenced
with a gale of wind from S. E. and
squally weather, Middle and Latter
part the same so ends

Tuesday Sept 30th Commenced
with a gale of wind from the S. E. and
squally weather, Middle part
S. W. Latter the same so ends

Wednesday Oct 1st Commenced
with a gale of wind from the S. E. and
squally weather, Middle and
Latter part the same so ends
