 Commences with fresh breeze
 from the Westward and cloudy
 weather Middle part wind from
 the North latter from the East
 ends
 Lat by Obs 31° 01'
 Long by Obs 137° 40'
 Monday Oct 17th Commences
 with fresh breezes from the N.W.
 and cloudy weather, Middle part
 the Westward latter from the East
 ends
 Lat by Obs 29° 19'
 Long by Obs 135° 20'
 Tuesday Oct 18th Commences
 with light baffling air from
 the Eastward and good weather
 Middle part light air from the S.W.
 latter the same as ends
 Lat by Obs 28° 33'
 Long by Obs 134° 00'
 Wednesday Oct 19th Commences
 with light breeze from the South
 and good weather, Middle part
 the same latter fresh breezes
 ends
 Lat by Obs 28° 00'
 Long by Obs 134° 30'
 Thursday Oct 20th Commences
 with strong breezes from the South
 and good weather, Middle part the
 same latter a gale of wind in
 ends with squally weather
 Lat by Obs 27° 33'
 Long by Obs 134° 28'
 Friday Oct 21th Commences
 with a gale of wind from the South
 and squally weather, Middle and
 latter part the same as ends
 Lat by Obs 27° 10'
 Long by Obs 134° 48'
 Saturday Oct 22th Commences
 with a gale of wind from the
 South and cloudy weather
 Middle part more moderate
 and squally latter the same
 as ends
 Lat by Obs 27° 00'
 Long by Obs 134° 10'

Sunday Oct 23rd 1853
 Commences with moderate breezes
 from the South and cloudy weather
 Middle part moderate breezes from
 the Eastward latter fresh breezes
 ends
 Lat by Obs 25° 18'
 Long by Obs 135° 30'
 Monday Oct 24th Commences
 with fresh breezes from the Eastward
 and squally, Middle and latter
 part the same as ends
 Lat by Obs 25° 47'
 Long by Obs 134° 30'
 Tuesday Oct 25th Commences
 with strong breezes from the Eastward
 and squally weather, Middle part
 the same at 8 A.M. saw the
 Land Nootka the East bearing South
 by compass about 25 miles dist at
 12 the West part bore N.W. by compass
 about 7 miles dist as ends
 Wednesday Oct 26th
 Commences fine breezes and good
 weather at 8 light baffling air
 from all points of the compass
 Middle and latter part the
 same as ends trying to get
 in to L'Anse
 Thursday Oct 27th Commences
 with light baffling air from all
 points of the compass at 3 P.M.
 came to anchor in 15 fathoms
 of water and 45 chain
