Strong breezes from S. W. Course S & E by E
to S. S. E at 4 P.M. saw a Schooner steering
N. N. E. Chose Boat crew Run & coiled lines
&c mid & latter parts Strong breeze from
S. W. by W Course S. S. E under courses
fiddle &c employed fitting Boat &c at
7 A.M. saw a Bark steering N & E

Saturday June 18th
Fresh breeze from S. W. by W. Schooner heading
to the South Rainy weather Working on Boat
at dark took in fore sail by the wind Southern
took latter part Rainy looked to Westward
Cruising Breaking out Ship for candles &c
Lat 31°25

Sunday June 19th Long 55°34
Fresh breeze from S. W. Cruising under easy sail
at dark took in fore sail rough sea wet decks
and beds schooner heading Westward Broke out
After hole for Boat Knives & Candles did not
find them latter part Rain Squalls & Calms
Rough S & E, Frigging on steering Apparatus &c
No observations

Monday June 20th Cloudy
Commenced with Cloudy Rainy Rough weather
Winds from S. W. to W. saw one sail from Northward
Sewed several Rips in Main sail Repaired
Bow Boat made line cover &c. At dark
steering & By S. mid and latter parts
steering Same saw a Steamer to South
and Porpoises Rough weather

Tuesday June 21st Long 54°02 West
Fresh breeze from S. W. Course S by S
latter part moderate Gale from S. W. hove to
under fore sail lashed Water But got out
Water saw a Dolphin fitted Toi sails &c
Rainy weather & seas coming aboard
from all quarters No lett &c
