at same latter part made all sail
smooth weather broke out B. & E

light breezes from S.W. by W. in weather
course S. by E all sail out at 5 P.M. toward
to try the boat at dusk took up boat and
took in all sail & set the fore & main
try sails at daylight made all sail
heading S. by E at 9 A.M. saw a schooner
to North

light breeze from S.S.W. schooner heading to
West ward at 3 P.M. Capt. Nickerson &
Boat crew went on board schooner
William A. Grozier, Roberts, Province Town,

all sail standing to S.W. saw several sails

Sunday June 26th

light breezes from S.E. to S.S.E. ship heading to S.W.
saw 4 schooners one cutting & 2 man overing for
whales saw porpoises at dusk took in all sail & set
main try sail, heading to the southward, at daylight made
all sail light breeze from S.E. steered off to S.W.
saw a large merchant man & 2 whaling schooners
some light rain & squalls

Monday June 27th
moderate breeze from S.E. schooner heading S.W.
by the wind, 3 sails in sight at dusk put on the
try sails, latter part made sail crossed
to West ward saw 2 sails from mast head
broke out water made cooler cover &
Antone Lombar Boat Steerer, off duty sick
Joseph Sylvia Boy Ben Sick all the time
since leaving home

Long 50-23 West

Tuesday June 28th
light breezes from S.W. cruising off to Westward
at 4-30 P.M. wore ship to S.S.E. cut a hole through
bulk head to give the men some air, at dusk
took in fore sail set try sail, saw a brig
connect to the North last Night & to Night
about 15 degrees above horizon, rising through
the Night, latter part good weather cruising
to S.E. saw Brig & schooner to South
crew variously employed

Lat 30-14 North

Long 49-59 West

Wednesday June 29th
light breeze from W.S.W. schooner heading
various courses cruising at 4 P.M. saw Black
fish going quick to West ward, saw 2 boats
did not get fast. Brought schooner in sight
shortened sail heading South, connect N.W. by W.
latter part light breeze from West ward
zigzagging around, cruising saw 2 sails
which employed fitting main boom &
tapping lift blocks & pins in bad order
