Begins with a light breeze from S by E the ship under all sail heading S by E & employed in sundry jobs about the ship lastly the water looking smaller Middle part a calm latter a light breeze from S by E the ship under all sail steady S by E thus ends the day

Monday Aug 11 1884

Begins with a light air from SSW the vessel under all sail heading S by E at 2 o'clock the deck away a calm Middle & latter part a light breeze from S the ship heading ESE see porpoises Trampses and Dolphins all hands washing thus ends the day

Tuesday Aug 12 1884

Begins with a brisk breeze from S the water clear the ship under all sail heading E by N all hands washing Middle & latter part a brisk breeze from S the ship heading E and E by N employed in breaking out the repair hatch for Beef and Pork also meat one sail in sight thus ends the day

Wednesday Aug 13 1884

Begins with a brisk breeze from S the vessel under all sail heading E by N employed in breaking out meat spoke and turned with the schooner Cleone Haven of Providence 2 months out 40 lbs Middle part a light breeze from the same latter part a calm employed in breaking out water Port side of Fore Hole see a school of Killis thus ends the day

Thursday Aug 14 1884

Begins with light air from SSW the ship heading E employed in sundry jobs about the ship one sail in sight at 4 AM the deck away a calm Lowered the Boats the Drill the men pooling Middle & latter a calm except in noon and the boats haws made same sail but took it in again a Bark and schooner in sight thus ends the day

Friday Aug 15 1884

Begins with a calm the vessel under the jibs and Fore sail and Main Tysail employed in sundry jobs about the ship 2 sails in sight Middle part a calm took in Fore aft sails and jobs latter part a moderate breeze from SW at 8 o'clock PM made all sail steady S by E thus ends the day

Saturday Aug 16 1884

Begins with a brisk breeze from SSW the water clear the vessel under all sail steady S by E employed in painting some around aft with the jobs about the ship got out Camerone for cabin use Middle & latter part a light breeze from SSW to W the ships bore S by E see porpoise a piece of squid and a plank got 4 Dolphins thus ends the day

Sunday Aug 17 1884

Begins with a light breeze from N to NW clear water the vessel under all sail steady S by W Run 2 shots of Lowline for small Lobst Middle & latter part a calm Lowered down all the sails except in Fore Topmast staysail one sail in sight to the S of us see a Thetis lowered for it did not get it thus ends the day
