

Sunday Sept 21 1884

Begins with a moderate breeze from E by E. No ship under the ship, under all sail steering SW a Merchant Brig in sight. Bore ship to the NE at sunset shortened sail and bore ship to the NE at 12 o'clock of Middle point. Wore ship heading E at daylight made all sail. Knap off SW by W. Latter part wind and weather the same. Thus ends the Day.

Monday Sept. 22. 1884

Begins with a moderate breeze from E. No ship under looking square. The ship under all sail steering SW by W at 1 o'clock A.M. wore ship steering N by E at 2 it came in squally shortened sail at sunset took in gill hauled by the wind heading N by E Middle & Latter part a light breeze from the same at daylight made sail the ship heading along N by E. The Cooper employed in making Baglight. The Captain making a New Bench. Thus ends the Day.

Tuesday Sept 23 1884

Begins with a light breeze from E with clear weather. No ship under all sail heading N by E at 3 o'clock A.M. a steam ship by the name of Burgee passed us bore to the NW at 20 minutes of 4 o'clock A.M. the 1 Mate Mr. Look raised a school of sperm whales breaching 4 fms on Port Bough 5 miles off Rock off for the Run down to the the whales were going to the SW slowly Cows and Calfs lowered 3 Boats the Laboard Boat struck and drew in. Finely struck and got over the Captain had 2 slits. Whales but did not faster at Clark got the whale along side shortened sail got uppers and set In watch. Middle point got Rocky to Cott. Latter part a fresh breeze from the same at daylight called all hands Hooked on the whale and took him in. Lat 34.56 N Long 38.14 W
Thus ends the Day.

Wednesday Sept 24 1884

Begins with a fresh breeze from E by S. No ship under. Jibs and In sail heading S employed in getting out Casts. In evening falls taking Blubber and cleaning the Case and sealing the works at half past 6 A.M. set In watch Middle & Latter part the same. The same at daylight wore ship heading to the NE one watch employed in boiling. The other watch employed in breaking salt for cabin stores and water. Thus ends the Day.

Thursday Sept 25. 1884

Begins with a light breeze from SE. No ship under. Short sail heading from E by N to E by S all hands employed in Bleating out cleaning up & at 3 o'clock A.M. finished Boiling the whale. Turning up from the boiler 15 lbs set Four Sail Middle part light air from the same. Latter part a calm employed in scrubbing off Decks and Repairing Tannegs & 2 sails in sight. Thus ends the Day.

Friday Sept 26 1884

Begins with a calm with heavy swell from NW. Employed in scrubbing jobs about the ship 2 sails and a steamer in sight at 6 A.M. sent a Boat on Board a Galician Bark 51 days from Buzargues. Bore to Cardiff at sunset. Look in In sail Middle point a calm. Latter part the same. A light breeze from E by N made some sail heading SE 2 sails in sight. Thus ends the Day.
