

Saturday Sept 27 1884

Begins with a fresh breeze from E by N
the vessel squally the ship under all sail
ready to be employed in stripping the New Bank
the Captain making a New Iceberch & 3 seals
in sight at sunset short sail at 12
o'clock of Middle part the ship heading NE
and at daylight the ship heading E by S
got up the Tackle to stow down latter part
a light breeze from the same stowed down the
oil on starboard side the whale making 13 lbs
Thus ends the Day

Sunday Sept 28 1884

Begins with a light breeze from
E by N the ship under all sail heading NE by N
employed in stowing away oil casks
and clearing up Decks at half past 2
the the Mate Boalsterer Crist's Raised
span Whales 1 Point on the Bow
going to the str. stow by a school of cows and
calves 4 miles off low end 3 Boats and
went down to them all 3 Boats struck
and got 3 Whales at dark got them
along side all hands Got Supper and
sett watches Middle part the wind the same
got all ready to be off at daylight called
all hands and Hooked on latter part
a fresh breeze from NE the ship heading NE
W. at 12 o'clock P.M. got the 3 Whales Got
m. Parted 2 botting falls in botting Rove
the third did one and finished Thus
ends the Day

Monday Sept. 29. 1884

Begins with a brisk breeze from NE
with fine weather the ship under short
sail heading NW employed in clearing
the waist unloading the Falls breaking out
for casks and cleared 1 Head at 4 P.M.
sett by watches Middle part the wind
the same the ship heading to the S by E
away 2 Heads and started to work
latter part a light breeze from E by S
the ship under main sail and Jibs
heading to the N see a school of killers
Thus ends the Day

Latitude 34 24 N
Longitude 37 33 W
Tuesday Sept. 30 1884

Begins with a light breeze from
E by N the ship under short sail
employed in Boiling and botting
Blubber the ship heading NE at sunset
look on main sail and Flying Jib
finished botting Blubber Middle part
part a light breeze from the same at
9 o'clock P.M. finished Boiling and put
the Fat team on to stew the 3 Whales
Boiling away from cooler 27 lbs Thus ends
the Day

Latitude 34 32 N
Longitude 37 15 W
Wednesday Oct 1 1884

Begins with a moderate breeze
from E by N the ship under short sail
heading NE by N employed in clearing up
Decks and unloading the oil casks at sunset
packed ship heading Middle part the same
latter part a fresh breeze from E by N made sail
steering from NE to NW the Captain made stations
to stage Thus ends the Day
