

Thursday Oct 2 1884

Begins with a light breeze from
S. the ship under all sail steering WNW
employed in sundry jobs about the ship
at sunset Lieut. May, a boat look in
all but staysails. Middle sent the same
boat with a light breeze from S. made
all sail steady W. Got up the big Tack
and broke out for cabin stores and
start Walter to run oil thus ends the
Day

Friday Oct 3 1884

Begins with a moderate breeze from
S. with clear weather the ship under all
sail steering W. employed in stowing
down oil at 4 o'clock A. M. finished the
3 Whales stowed down 28 the stowage up
the Hob in main Hatch at 5 A. M. at
sunset shortened sail and lashed ship
heaving S. by Middle & Latta sent a
fresh breeze from S. made some sail steady
SW broke out a new Colting Fall and stowed
away oil casks thus ends the Day

Saturday Oct 4 1884

Begins with a fresh breeze from
S. the ship under four sail jibs and by
sail steady WSW employed in pointing
Colting Fall & one sail in sight at sunset
shortened sail lashed ship heaving S. by
Middle & Latta sent a fresh breeze from S. the
ship heaving S. on starboard Tack at 7 o'clock
A. M. the mates Boatman raised a school of Killers
or Whales could not make them out on Lee Bow he
going to windward very quick made sail and Tack
every 2 hours at 9 lost sight of them thus ends the Day

Sunday October 5 1884

Begins with a fresh breeze from
SSW the ship under all sail except the
Topsails working to windward heaving S.
on one Tack W by S on the other see a self
heaving on and 1 Grampuses at sunset
shortened sail heaving S. by Middle sent
light breeze from the same the weather was
Latta sent commences with a breeze at 8
o'clock P. M. then sprung up a light air from
S. kept the ship to thus ends the Day

Longitude 36.35 W

Monday Oct 6 1884

Begins with a light air from
the ship under four sail and jibs and by
sail steady WNW heavy squalls heaving
around at sunset took in jibs heaving
S. by Middle & Latta sent a boat with
quite a swell from NW see Grampuses thus
ends the Day

Latitude 34.09 N
Longitude 36.51 W
Tuesday Oct 7 1884

Begins with a light air from
the ship heaving W at 12 o'clock A. M. Lieut. May
a boat look in all sail except the
staysail at 12 o'clock of Middle sent the
sprung up a light air from NW the ship
heaving W with four sail and jib Latta
sent much the same employed in breaking
out for water and flower thus ends
the Day
