

Wednesday Oct 8 1884

Begins with a light breeze from N. The ship under all sail steering NW. & employed in sandy jobs about ship at sunset shortened sail. Night & Latte sent a brisk breeze from N. to E. steering the same course at daylight set jibs put new straps on some Tackle Blocks & thus ends the Day

Thursday Oct. 9. 1884

Begins with a brisk breeze from E to ESE the weather rather squally. The ship under fore sail jibs and try sail being set at 2 o'clock A.M. changed the course to N. & employed in various jobs about the ship at sunset took in jibs hipped to the wind heading N. by E. Night Latte sent the same. Latte sent a strong breeze from SE at 9 o'clock P.M. set jib and wore ship heading S by W see one in back thus ends the Day

Friday Oct 10 1884

Begins with a very strong breeze from ESE to SE quite a swell from NW at sunset shortened sail and wore ship heading E. Night Latte & Latte sent a very strong breeze from the same the weather was squally with a bad sea employed in covering the leading hose to the fore pump one merchant ship was sighted bore to N. N. E. thus ends the Day

Saturday Oct. 11, 1884

Begins with a very strong breeze from SE to SSE the weather squally with heavy sea the ship under short sail heading from N. by E to E. & see merchant ships bore and Eastward. Night Latte sent the same. Latte sent blowing a moderate gale from SSE the weather thick foggy and rain. Bared down the Hatches thus ends the Day

Longitude. 37.22 W
Sunday Oct. 12, 1884

Begins with a moderate gale from SSE the weather thick the ship under single reef fore sail fore staysail and try sail at 3 o'clock A.M. breezed on heavy rollers down the stay sails but she made bad weather of it ripped the gird set the at 4 A.M. put another reef in fore sail the sea running heavy took the things out the boats. Night Latte sent the wind shifted to the S and moderated some the ship heading S by E to Latte sent blowing quite strong from the same the weather thick and rainy thus ends the Day

No. Observation
Monday Oct. 13. 1884
Begins with a strong breeze from S with saw sea the weather thick and rainy the ship under reefed sails heading S by E at sunset it cleared up some. Night Latte & Latte sent a moderate breeze from the same the weather thick and rainy made some sail heading the same thus ends the Day
