

Saturday Nov 8 1884

Begins with a strong breeze in squalls from E to W with heavy rain some with fogged sea the ship under fore sail fore stay sail and part of the time with the jib set also main top sail heading S by N Midle & Latta part blowing strong in squalls from E to N and a driving rain saw the ship under short sail heading from S by E thus ends the Day

No. Observation

Sunday, Nov. 9, 1884

Begins with a very strong breeze from N to W with thick and heavy rain the ship under fore sail fore stay sail and main top sail a part of time with jib out at 4 o'clock A.M. it became on to rain and blow to sea rising fast Ripped down sprig and took up boats heading S by E Midle & Latta part blowing heavy and raining with heavy sea decks full of water all night whole ship heading N to N

John Ferguson the Cook full and hurt his shoulder quite bad took James Smith from Port Watch for Cook thus ends the Day

No. Observation

Monday, Nov. 10, 1884

Begins with a moderate gale from E to N the weather very thick and rainy the ship under 2 Riff fore sail fore stay sail and Ripped main top sail heading N to E at 1 o'clock A.M. the ship heading S by E Midle part much the same Latta part rather more moderate left off at the Riffs and set the jib Ripped off a thus ends the Day

No. Observation

Tuesday, Nov. 11, 1884

Begins with a fresh breeze from E to N the weather thick and rainy the ship under fore sail and jibs and main top sail heading from E to S by W see a school of porpoises Midle part the same Latta part it cleared away sloped raining set main sail and flying jib see tide Riffs at 9 o'clock P.M. squally look in main sail thus ends the Day

Longitude 40.51. W

Wednesday, Nov. 12, 1884

Begins with a brisk breeze from E to W with overcast the ship under all sail except the topsails stay S by E at sundown took on main sail flying jib Midle part a light breeze from E to N the ship heading from S by E to S Latta part quite a fresh breeze from E to W clearing up made all sail heading S by E thus ends the Day

Longitude 40.07. W

Thursday, Nov. 13, 1884

Begins with a moderate breeze from E to W the weather quite clear the ship under all sail heading S by E in company in repairing sundry things about ship Midle & Latta part a stiff breeze from the same the weather thick and rainy took in the topsails see plenty porpoises and tide Riffs thus ends the Day
