

Wednesday, Nov. 26, 1884

Begins with a calm. The weather thick and serene. Took in sail one sail in sight a Bark steering to the N at sunset it cleared up some. Middle part the same until 4 o'clock then sprung up a light breeze from N to N E the ship's course S by E latter part the same. Painted the Port side of Cabin Trunk & Masts the Day

Thursday, Nov. 27, 1884

Begins with a light breeze from E to the weather looking squally to leeward the ship under all sail steering S by E see popovers and a jumper at 3 o'clock the wind backed from E to N E at sunset it became more steady from N E Middle & latter part a calm employed in painting in the cabin and sundries other jobs see a school of Grampuses this evening the Day

Friday, Nov. 28, 1884

Begins with a calm the ship with all sail taken in employed in painting the Galley & c at sunset had light airs and variable from N to N E the ship's course S by E at sunset took in sail and jib. Middle part a calm latter part light airs from N to S the course the same employed in breaking out for water and meat one sail in sight this evening the Day

Saturday, Nov. 29, 1884

Begins with light airs from the S with quite a swell from the same the ship under fore sail jibs and top sail reaching east employed in stowing off mail Hatches & c 2 sails in sight Middle & latter part light airs and variable from all points of compass with plenty of rain overhauled the block of fore sail & Masts the Day

Sunday, Nov. 30, 1884

Begins with a calm the sails all lowered down employed in sundries jobs about ship 2 sails in sight Middle part light airs and variable from all points in the compass with plenty of rain latter part a light breeze from S made all sail steering S by E 2 sails in sight steering to the S E Masts the Day

Monday, Dec. 1, 1884

Begins with light airs and frequent squalls from S to S W the ship under all sail heading S by E at 5 o'clock to N at 12 o'clock a calm lowered down the fore and aft sails one sail in sight Middle part a calm comment of latter part a fresh breeze in a squall from S W made all sail the course the same at 9 o'clock P.M. did away a calm took in all sail 2 sails in sight this evening the Day
