Begins with a fresh breeze from N by E the ship under all sail except the topsails heading N by E at sunset shortened sail and Tacked ship heading S by S Middle & Latta part a strong breeze from the same way ship at 1 o'clock of Middle part at 7 o'clock of Latta part kept off S by S under short sail thus ends the day

Monday, Dec. 15, 1884

Begins with a strong breeze from E by N the weather smokey the ship under short sail heading S by S see 2 Humpbacks and a school of Blackfish going quick to the N E Middle & Latta part a strong breeze from the same at daylight wore ship heading N by E and set the jib see Blackfish to windward thus ends the day

Tuesday, Dec 16, 1884

Begins with a strong breeze from E by N with a heavy sea the weather cloudy and smokey the ship under short sail heading from N by N to E see one Humpback going to the S at sunset took in jib Middle part the wind the same the weather squally with rain at daylight wore ship to the S & Latta part a strong breeze from E by E the ship heading S and S by E Broke out cabin stoves set the jib thus ends the day

Wednesday, Dec. 17, 1884

Begins with a strong breeze from E by E the ship under short sail heading S by S at sunset wore ship heading N by N at 12 o'clock of Middle part wore ship heading S by S the weather squally plenty of rain Latta part strong breeze from the same the weather the same at 11 o'clock PM wore ship heading N by N see 2 Humpbacks going quick to windward and thus ends the day

Thursday, Dec. 18, 1884

Begins with a strong breeze from E by E the weather squally the ship under short sail heading N by E at sunset took in jib Middle & Latta part blowing very strong from E by S the weather dreary thus ends the day

Friday, Dec. 19, 1884

Begins with a very strong breeze from E by E the weather thick and rainy the ship under full sail from day sail and main try sail heading N by E at 4 o'clock AM wore ship heading S by S Middle & Latta part the wind the same the weather thick and rainy with thunder and lightning at 11 PM it died away a calm split fore sail took it in thus ends the day

No. Observation

Saturday, Dec. 20, 1884

Begins with a strong breeze from E by E the weather rainy the ship under short sail Ribbed fore sail and set it at 5 AM wore ship heading N by E the weather clearing up Middle & Latta part a fresh breeze from E with some rain Broke out water land set the jib thus ends the day
